It is the Greek word, "Pleroma." I dare not attempt to translate it.

It means the "fulness of the fulness" and the "completeness of the completeness" and then it is not translated.

It has the fragrance of the Cross, of suffering, of the Resurrection, of His triumph over Satan and the Glory of His Sitting Down at the Right Hand of the Father all in it—and of His Pleroma or "fulness" have we all received and Grace upon Grace."

I know this is true.

I know that we have received it, I know that we have it now.

I know that we have His completeness, the utter fulness of this Redemptive work in Christ.

I know that in Col. 2:9 "In Him ye are made complete," or "ye are made full."

The finished work has made you complete in Him.

Here it is again:

Eph. 3:19 says, "that ye may be filled unto all the fulness, the completeness of God."

When the Bride is brought in before the Bridegroom she is garmented with all that is necessary to make her absolutely perfect before the gaze of friends, foe or lover.

When you come to stand before the Father you will stand there in utter fulness—completeness.

When you enter the place of intercession you enter it in "the fulness" of your Lord; you enter it in the utter completeness, the utter sufficiency of your Lord.

1 Cor. 13:13 "These characteristics, or gifts, of God that abide in the New Testament. These are hope, faith, and the greatest being love. These are developed that we may know the Father in His love."

Christ is the source of life for its Salvation. We study the Word that God provides for our edification, hope, and joy. The hope becomes a reality for the soul, for it is a gift of God's faith. Heb. 6:18-20.

Hope alone, however, does not make God real to us. James 1:22-25 us to become doers of the Word, not hearers (hoppers) only. The Word is acting in our lives. The Word, the act of faith that God's blessings into reality. Heb. 11:1.

Faith is more than an act of the body; it is the act of the threefold man, the spirit, soul (mind) and body. The spirit acts when it loves, trusts, etc. The mind acts when it studies and thinks. The body acts when it moves. Rom. 10:9-10 tells us that with the heart man believes unto righteousness and Rom. 12:12 tells us to present our bodies a living sacrifice, and to become renewed in mind. This unqualified committal of one's whole self to Christ is faith.

Math. 7:14 declares that narrow is the gate that leads unto life. This narrow way is faith in Christ's Redemptive work. No other way will avail. Feelings do not bring reality. Another's faith will not do it. Others can inspire us to act, but they cannot do our acting. Hope, as we have seen, is not faith. Knowledge is not faith. It gives us the foundation to our faith, however. Good works will not produce faith, though faith produces good works. Our receiving the blessings of God then narrows down to one thing, and that is faith in Christ.

This does not make for a limited life. The way into it merely is limited. God cannot honor anything except what He has provided for us in Christ, and our acceptance of that work brings us into all the blessings. Eph. 1:3. When the Christian has made the unqualified committal, he enters into a life that is broader than anything he has known heretofore. The Father manifests Himself in all His fullness and love comes into its own. It is as this love is developed that the Christian becomes established. The Father and the Master come in to abide, John 14:23, and the heart finds its rest. This is the goal of the Christian's life for until he finds this fellowship of love he is ever seeking.

Chinese New Testament and Psalms

A gratifying bit of news comes from China of the completion of the work of editing a new translation of the New Testament and Psalms into Chinese. Dr. John C. H. Wu, a Chinese jurist, was commissioned by Chiang Kai-shek to make a new translation of the New Testament and the Psalms into Chinese. Chiang Kai-shek himself performed the outstanding work of editing the manuscript of over 200,000 Chinese characters. With painstaking care, Chiang Kai-shek went over the manuscript making numerous corrections and improvements. The task of editing began nearly two years ago at a critical phase of the war, was a carefully kept secret until revealed only recently.

What Redemption Covers

In the four gospels we get very little of what Redemption means. It is necessary that we turn to Paul's Revelation to find what the Redemptive work of Christ means to the Father and may mean to the church.

Redemption was a Revelation of God in Christ saving a lost world.

These are a few of the great things that Redemption gave to man. He may not appreciate them. He may not enter into his rights and privileges, nevertheless, they await him.

Jn. 8:36 "If therefore the Son shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed" or in reality. This means freedom from Satan's dominion. This means liberty, a thing for which humanity has striven through the ages. But it can only be found in Christ.

"Whosoever committeth sin is the bond servant of sin." These are the words of the Master. But the Son came to put sin away by the sacrifice of Himself.

When you accept Christ as your Saviour and crown Him as your Lord, God makes you a New Creation.

He takes the sin nature out of you and imparts His own nature to you.

The moment you are Born Again, sin's dominion is broken over you and you are free.

Then if sin gains the dominance over you again, all you need to do is to confess it to the Father and the moment you do He cleanses you from the effect of that sin.

Jesus is seated at His right hand as your advocate or lawyer. He said, "I write unto you little children that you sin not, but if any do sin we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous."

The moment you sin you lose your standing, but you have this Righteous Advocate who will plead your case with the Father. So you need not live under condemnation one moment after you sin. Sin shall not have dominion over you for you are not under Satan any longer.

"There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus." Freedom from condemnation is freedom from the sense of guilt and sin.

Freedom from sin gives us what the Word calls Righteousness.

Rom. 4:25 "He was delivered up on the account of our trespasses and was raised because we were declared Righteous." This scripture shows that Jesus would not have been raised unless we were Justified.

If we are Justified we have peace with God. We have peace with our own hearts.

We have passed out of the realm of guilt and unworthiness. We have passed into the realm of Sonship with all its blessings and privileges.

The church has failed to grasp the significance of Redemption. It has made a philosophy of it or a theology.

It is neither. It is a simple fact: That Christ died for our sins according to scripture and when He had put sin away and conquered Satan, He arose from the dead.

After Jesus had borne the sins and diseases of the world and died under the judgment of them, He went down to the place where we should have gone and suffered until the claims of justice were fully met. Then He was Justified, made alive in spirit. He met the adversary and conquered him, stripped him of his authority, and paralyzed his death-dealing authority.

Then He arose from the dead and shouted, "All Hail." Redemption morn had come. He carried His blood into the Heavenly Holy of Holies and poured it out on the Mercy seat and it was accepted by the Father.

Then He sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high. A perfect Redemption had been con-

summated. A perfect Righteousness had been restored to man. A perfect peace that passeth understanding, that is beyond the range of Sense Knowledge was given to him.

Not only that, but we were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Cor. 1:9 Fellowship is the climax of Redemption. You might have all the other things, but if you did not have fellowship you would live in misery.

Marriage gives the right to fellowship, but if fellowship is broken the marriage becomes filled with misery.

Following fellowship comes love. The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts. We have partaken of the love nature of the Father. Now we walk in love. Now we can live the Jesus life.

We take Jesus' place as lovers. The word of faith has become a part of our very lives.

His Word is abiding in us. It dwells in us richly. This Word of faith produces in us the faith of the Son of God.

What a marvelous thing this Redemption is. It restores to us our lost health, for, "By His stripes we are healed."

We have perfect joy and fellowship with Him. We can see that our lost freedom has been restored. Our lost Righteousness has been regained.

Our lost peace once more fills our hearts. Our lost fellowship is restored.

Love, the thing that makes Jesus a reality, once more is crowned in the heart of man. The lost faith that takes man out of the realm of timidity and fearfulness and makes him stand in the presence of his enemies a conqueror is once more enjoyed by man.

LEPER WORK IN AFRICA

There came a leper—to a missionary nurse working for souls in a small dispensary at Nala in the heart of Africa. And with him, came the challenge; a vision of the need, a prayer for the need, a prayer for her own need, and through her, Jesus touched him.

Thus the first leper work commenced. Trees were cut down and bush cleared. Houses were put up and food planted. Years of toil and learning how best to help, then the joy of seeing men and women born anew and sent home clean. Beginnings! God met all her needs.

Then came a new advance to Nebobongo, a forest in 1940. The missionary, now Mrs. Percy Moules, with her husband, both duly qualified at L'Ecole Tropicale de Medecine at Antwerp, Belgium, lived in a shack while they attacked the forest—acres and acres of it. In collaboration with the Belgian Red Cross they took over the care of all the lepers of Chief Boanoku of the Mabudu tribe. Very little segregation had been done, and all types of leprosy were treated. They started two camps, one with 39 lepers at Bakiane and a larger camp at Mabese adjoining their own concession at Nabobongo.

Now well over 1200 lepers are being treated and there is a boarding school of 75 women and girls, together with a boy's boarding school of about 80, industrial school, organized occupational therapy, dispensary, hospital and church. In the past three years, about 200 cases have been discharged as symptom free and many cases without crippling, for the propaganda of success has meant a great increase in early cases coming in for treatment. And more important, many have returned home Christians. Many adult lepers have been taught to read God's Word.

An untainted children's nursery thrives with 40 little children who have been rescued from leprosy. Some have already passed through the kindergarten school and had some industrial training.

Hundreds, both men and women, have been inspired to self-help and contribute to the communal life of the camp. The first meetings under the banana trees of about 30 have now grown to gatherings of some hundreds, among whom are many born-again believers whose lives are radiant.

A burnt-brick-built maternity hospital was built with ante and post-natal clinics where already hundreds of women have been helped and lives saved. Three hundred women with their children attend the Child Welfare Clinic and many of them have been won for Christ here and at the Hospital.

Above all, during these last months, since the sudden home-call of Mr. Moules, God has given a wave of revival blessing. There has been conviction of sin and a turning to God. Souls have been won, Christians stirred to a closer walk with God, a victorious experience, a longing for holiness and Life more abundant in Christ Jesus.

An appeal from those in authority has come to us from the Gold Coast where there are about 10,000 lepers. What a challenge! What an opportunity to advance the Gospel into the unevangelized area of the Gold Coast.

An appeal also came from Liberia, which is one of the needy, dark spots of the West Coast of Africa.

There is great need not only for finances to carry on the work among the lepers but for those who are willing to go. There is need for doctors, for nurses and above all for trained men and women whom God will thrust forth to meet this challenge . . . those who know their calling, and with a burning passion for souls. Men and women of faith and vision; of grit and determination; those who remember the words of Christ; "As the Father hath sent Me, even so send I you."

We want to express our hearty thanks for the trouble you have taken in collecting everything you have sent across to the Philippines. This expression of love from the hearts of God's children has brought us much joy and gladness.

Everything is going on fine by the help and guidance of our Lord Jesus. Last Saturday, November 23rd, twenty-nine accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as personal Saviour in our first out station. We had a wonderful service. The people are hungry for the truth.

After our Sunday morning service, we went to the second out station to hold services. Eight souls accepted the Lord as personal Saviour. You will be glad to know our ex-Mayor came with us and attended our service. Before, he was a member of Spiritualism. He is saved now. Please pray for him that the Lord will guide him through all the way.

There are some more out stations in La Union and Mountain province. It is about two months now that I have not been there because I have so many works and also I am lacking of financial means yet. Nevertheless the Lord is still with them. My son came here to visit and get some rice to eat and he said that they have no Pastor but Jesus is their Pastor. There are many who are calling for services and I am praying that the Lord will have His way.

The other day a Barrio lieutenant came to see us, asking if we can schedule services once a week in his town. I told him we would pray for that. We decided on services every Saturday afternoon for the children and in the evening for the adults.

The young people were very happy to go with me to do the service in all the stations. How much more we could do if we had a Gospel car to use for His Glory.

Also stations in the provinces of La Union and Mountain. Please, continue to pray for these places. The harvest truly is plenteous but the laborers are few. Pray for us that God use us mightily to win souls and that He will supply our needs so we will not be hindered in bringing the Gospel to those who are dying without Christ.

We also ask you to remember the needs of the twenty-two students in our Bible School. They are particularly in need of clothing.

Our greatest need is for money and supplies to re-build the church. We have already the gift of \$150. With this we have bought cement and clip and posts for the foundations. We will still need \$450 to complete the rebuilding. Please pray for us.

The Seven-Fold Ministry of Our Lord on the Throne of Grace

WILLARD H. POPE, D.D.

Comparatively speaking, little is understood today, on the part of the average Christian, of the importance of the Present Ministry of our Lord on the Throne of Grace.

Many songs have been written and are being sung about the Cross.

We wear the cross in the lapel of our coats. We place it on the steeple of our churches. Priests wave it above the smoldering incense in their ministry before the icons and images.

With many such people, the blood of Christ, shed on the Cross, is the end of Redemption's story, but in reality it is only the beginning. For this reason many have gone no further in their experience than the Cross.

They know little of the victorious life because they know little of the present ministry of our Lord on the Throne of Grace. "Faith cometh by hearing, hearing by the Word." One cannot have faith beyond their hearing of the Word.

The facts are, if Jesus had not risen from the dead, and returned to heaven with His blood to pour it out upon the altar, before the Throne of Grace, in the Holy of Holies, all that He had accomplished on the Cross would have been of no avail, either legally or experimentally, in the lives of His children.

When Jesus said: "The works that I do, ye shall do also, and greater works than these shall ye do, because I go unto the Father," He most certainly had reference to His present sevenfold Ministry before the Throne of Grace in the Holy of Holies in Heaven.

The objectives for which He had died on the Cross, could not become an accomplished fact legally or experimentally until He conquered death and hell, arose from the dead and returned to Heaven with His blood to occupy the Father's Throne as our representative in Heaven.

It stands revealed in this statement of our Lord, there is that in His present ministry on the Throne of Grace that becomes the agency, may I say, through which His power and ability is to accomplish in our lives all that He legally accomplished for us in His death and resurrection from the dead.

A careful analysis of the Scriptures on this subject reveals there is a seven-fold ministry of Christ on the Throne of Grace. A continuous ministry since the very moment He returned to Heaven and sat down with His Father on His Throne.

That ministry will continue until He steps down from that Throne to return to meet His Church in the air. We shall see, that the moment Christ steps down from that Throne of Grace to meet His victorious, resurrected and raptured church in the air, that that Throne shall cease to be a Throne of Grace, and will revert to a Throne of "Divine Justice" and Judgment, as it was before Jesus occupied it as our Mediator.

But now let me call your attention to the present seven-fold ministry of our Lord on the Throne of Grace.

There are seven official positions that reveal the over-all picture of that wonderful ministry: our High Priest, our Mediator, our Intercessor, our Advocate, Minister of the Sanctuary, The Surety of the Covenant, and Our Lord.

Each of these official positions reveal a certain phase of His blessed ministry for and in us. (This will be continued in a special series of articles.)
