## SEVEN-FOLD MINISTRY OF CHRIST

In our previous articles we have shown you there are seven official positions our Lord occupies on the Throne of Grace. These reveal the over-all picture of that wonderful ministry.

He is our High Priest, our Mediator, our Intercessor, our Advocate, Minister of the Sanctuary, The Surety of the Covenant, and our Lord. Each of these official positions reveal a certain phase of His Present Ministry for and in us.

As our High Priest, He entered Heaven with His own blood as evidence before the Supreme Court of the Universe, that sin had been taken away, and the New Covenant relationship between the Father and His family could now be established on legal grounds.

As Mediator, He now brings the sinner to the Father in Reconciliation.

### Intercessor

He then becomes our Intercessor.

Our acceptance with the Father depends upon His Intercession for us. "Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us." Rom. 8:34. "Wherefore He is able to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing that He ever liveth to make intercession for them." Heb. 7:25.

His ministry of Intercession begins for the sinner when He, as Mediator, presents him to God. Jesus pleads His own precious blood as the evidence of Redemption from sin having been accomplished for the sinner. He pleads with the Father His own Righteousness as a substitution for man's unrighteousness. He intercedes for the sinner on the basis of legality, for the debt has been settled. As an attorney before the Court pleads for his client, Jesus pleads our case.

To intercede is to pray, plead, beg and continue the case in behalf of another. Thus Jesus EVER LIVETH to continue intercession on our behalf as our High Priest and Mediator.

### Advocate

The fourth official position of our Lord in this heavenly ministry is as our Advocate.

As Advocate it becomes a matter of our relationship to the Father as sons. An Advocate is one who defends, pleads for one who speaks in favor of another. An Advocate is one who is called to aid and plead the cause of another. Thus we read in 1 John 2:1-2, "My little children these things write I unto you that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous; and He is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for the whole world."

In becoming a propitiation for our sins, He simply pleads before the Throne of Grace that He has expiated our sins through His suffering the punishment due us, and that the sins of His children have already been judged in Himself.

This does not mean a license for living in sin on the part of the children. It is a Revelation of the fact that a provision has been made for those who may be overtaken in sin and in broken fellowship with the Father, and who return to the Father in true repentance.

There are different classes of sin. There is the sin of Commission. There is also the sin of Omis-

sion. In John 3:4, we read, "... Sin is the transgression of the Law." This is the sin of Commission. But on the other hand it is not always what we do that constitutes sin. It may be the things we fail to do. "To him therefore that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin." Ja. 4:14. Again we read, "... whatsoever is not of faith is sin." Rom. 13:23.

When we consider the good many of the Father's children should do, and fail to do, when we consider the fact that every act and thought of our lives that is not of Faith is sin, we can plainly see the need of an Advocate for the children of God.

Oh, how many of the children are out of fellowship with the Father these days! Doubt, fear, strife, envy, jealousy are elements with which the children have to contend in this material world. These elements that are foreign to Divine Love will break our fellowship with the Father if allowed a place in our hearts. This does not mean that we have been cut off, or that we have lost our relationship with the Father. Not by any means. Many who have broken fellowship have not gone so far as to "count the blood wherewith they were sanctified an unholy thing and done despite to the spirit of Grace."

Many, not having been taught the ministry of Jesus as an Advocate for them, have become discouraged and defeated. Many continue in condemnation and out of fellowship with the Father because they have not known that Jesus is officiating on the Throne of Grace as their Advocate.

## FEAR AND FAITH

Fear and Faith are fruits of the spirit.

Fear may be augmented and strengthened by the reasoning faculties, and often is, but fear itself is the product of your spirit.

Often times your reason tells you there is no danger whatever, and yet you are filled with a nameless dread and a nameless fear.

That comes, not from the reasoning faculties, not from any physical condition, but purely from your spirit.

The same thing is true in regard to love.

Love is the fruit of the spirit—the human spirit. We are not talking about the Holy Spirit, we are talking about our own spirits.

Faith and love, and fear and hope, all find their home, their fountain, in the spirit of man.

And then when the spirit of man is recreated and filled with the life of God, and his being governed and controlled by the Word of God, through the Holy Spirit, then love comes to floodtide; fear is driven out and the spirit comes to a liberty and freedom that only absence of fear will give it.

Then faith rises and becomes the dominant force in the spirit.

The relation of our reasoning faculties to our spirit is very intimate.

The reasoning faculties are usually antagonistic to faith, and so the reasoning faculties must be brought under the dominion of the Word of God; let the Word soak in, and soon the reasoning faculties will be in perfect harmony with the spirit.

Then faith and love really function.

But, the reason that faith is so feeble in many who are really devout people is because the reason is living in utter rebellion against the Word of God and the reason is dominated by the world-mind, through articles they read in the magazines and the daily papers, books, and conversations that they have with people.

I was thinking this morning of a certain young man in whom I am greatly interested, and whose future is going to be along musical lines, without any doubt. If he were wise he would put himself in contact with musicians, and the best musicians available; he would seek to be in their company and listen to their conversation, catch their spirit, and become familiar with their musical training and ability.

But instead of that he is choosing as his companions people who have no interest in music whatever. They love it on the radio and enjoy it, but that is as far as it goes. That man is hindering his own future and standing in the way of his own ambitions and desires.

Now you Christians are mingling and spending your best hours in idle hours in idle talk, or serious talk, it may be—with the world-mind, with unregenerate minds, minds that are utterly dominated by the prince of the powers of the air, and then you wonder why it is that you cannot get into the Bible and the Bible does not open to you.

You see, you are feeding your reason upon poison all the time, and then you want your reason to function perfectly with the Word of God and with your renewed spirit.

It cannot be done.

Now your mind and reasoning faculties are renewed as the Holy Spirit applies the Word of God to them, as you meditate on the Word; as you give yourself to the Word, the Word begins to func-

tion and begins to operate on your reason.

But you do not give it the opportunity. You keep it soaking all the time in an atmosphere that is doubtful to faith and to love.

No wonder you are a failure!  
No wonder you are weak!

If you give yourself over to companionship with God through the Word, and you feed on the Word, meditate on the Word, live according to the Word—meditate while you have the opportunity on some of the great scriptures and the great teachings of the Word, until your whole being, your mental being is being lifted and cleansed by the Word.

Jesus said, "Now are ye clean through the Word."

The Word washes your soul and washes your spirit, and they in turn begin to cleanse the life-streams in your body.

I know this is true, that the Word of God gets into our blood, into the bloodstream, and the life of God goes pouring through the life-streams in our body, through the arteries, forces itself into every part of our body, bringing healing and health and life there.

On the other hand, you live in the world-mind, you revel in that, you read world literature and talk world talk, and that gets into the bloodstream, and that carries with it a bitterness, an antagonism, a callousness that poisons your physical body.

"If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatsoever ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

It is the Word of Christ abiding richly in you, dominating your reasoning faculties, dominating your spirit, dominating your physical life—there is where power comes, healing comes, life comes, joy comes—that is the source, it is the literal Word of God abiding in you.

Hear what Jesus said "The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit and they are life."

The words of Jesus, all of the Old Testament, all that Paul wrote, are the words of Jesus, and they are life to your spirit, they are life to your soul, and they are health to your body.

You cannot live in the realm of the world-mind without its deadening your spiritual apprehension of divine things and robbing you of the glory and the joy of the Lord.

It is like taking one of those 8 candle-power light globes and trying to read by it; one of those old fashioned ones, the first one that Mr. Edison put out; or taking an old candle like mother used to make, or a lamp when the chimney is smoking.

Don't you understand me?

You cannot get the best out of it if the world-mind is weakening you, ruining your spiritual sight and dimming the lamp of your soul.

The lamp of the soul is the spirit, and you smother it with the world-thinking and world-companionship.

You get alone with Him, and oh, the sense of cleanliness that will come over you.

"If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you"—"If ye abide in the Word, then are ye my disciples"—that is the secret of it.

"The earth is full of the loving kindness of Jehovah." Psm. 33:5.

## Learning to Walk By Faith

#### We Have His Ability

The child has to learn to walk for himself. The parents who furnish the example and exhortation, and who so eagerly await the child's first step would gladly take it for him, but in the nature of the case, they just can't do it. Our Heavenly Father who awaits our walking by faith would gladly do the walking for us, but He cannot. He gives us the ability that we may do the walking for ourselves. We do it with His ability that He bestowed upon us when we were redeemed.

We have the ability for we have our Redemption. Why not venture out? But, it isn't a venture, for venture implies uncertainty, and there is no uncertainty in walking by faith. Our eyes and our other senses may at times deceive us, but faith can never deceive. Faith is of God, and there is no deception with Him. Faith is the only sure thing there is upon this earth. The ability to walk by faith comes as we keep our spiritual sight turned in the right direction, that is, upon Jesus. "Looking unto Jesus." This is really looking at the Word. "Belief cometh of hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ." Rom. 10:17. Peter walked on the water as long as he kept his eyes steadfastly fixed upon the Word Incarnate. He didn't take into account or even consider the wind and waves (the testimony of the senses) while he was walking. But they clamored for consideration, and he yielded. Then he began to sink. His very giving thought to the witness of his senses was his downfall. It caused doubt to enter, and when doubt enters faith goes out the door.

Faith and doubt never exist together. They are mutually exclusive. They are antagonistic. We either believe or we don't believe. There is no fence-sitting. Jesus had to so disappointedly exclaim to Peter as He stretched forth his hand and took hold of him, "O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?" Peter walked part of the way by faith, so he could have walked all the way.

It should be easier for us today to walk by faith than it was for Peter. We have quite an advantage over him, for we live this side of the Cross. We have Redemption in all its glorious fullness. We have a complete knowledge of this marvelous blessing as given to the Apostle Paul. It was made known by special Revelation to Paul so that all the New Creation might possess it and enjoy it.

#### Faith Does Things

The last half of this short but vital verse of Scripture is usually neglected or superficially treated. It deserves more attention. It reads, "not by sight." Does this mean, then, that we are to grope our way through life like a blind man? Yes, it does mean exactly that, as far as dependence upon natural sight is concerned. We are to be just like a blind man, naturally speaking. Much of the time we won't be able to see at all. That is, we won't be able to apprehend with the natural senses. The New Creation possesses another sight. It is surer and more certain than physical sight. Often physical sight deceives us and is misleading. Faith never deceives us, because it has the dependability and certainty of God, Himself. Faith rests only upon God and His Word. It sees only God and His Word.

Faith is stronger and mightier than mere natural sight. Faith does things. It calls into play laws that are higher and more powerful than the natural laws. In making the natural laws God didn't exhaust Himself. He held plenty of plans and powers in reserve. We are able to tap and use these superior, God-reserved powers by our living wholly by faith. Faith moves mountains! Faith calls into being that which is not. It actually creates. The Revised

Standard Version of Rom. 4:17 reads, "Who calls into existence the things that do not exist." The new Catholic translation of the New Testament causes Heb. 11:3 to read, "By faith we understand that the world was fashioned by the word of God; and thus things visible were made out of things invisible." God created the Universe by faith, and it is by faith that we understand it. He had faith that His Word would cause it to come into being. He acted upon that faith by saying the word, and the world, that had no existence, that was invisible, came into existence. Faith is more powerful than all the powers of the five senses combined.

We must expect direct and seemingly inviolable contradiction between faith and sight. Sight will say that you cannot do it. It will ridicule the possibility of your affecting a miracle. All the laws of nature told Peter it was utterly impossible for him to walk upon water. He had never seen anyone do it except Christ. He likely was unable to explain the working of the laws of gravity, that causes an object to seek its lowest possible level, but he knew the law and had seen its inexorable working all his life. How many times he had waded out into the lake in mending his nets, disentangling them, and in launching his boat. But here his refusal even to think about these laws, and his considering only the fact that it was God's will, as evidenced by Jesus' instructing him to come, enabled him to defy all nature's laws. He walked upon the water! This affords a perfect example of walking by faith. We can, and should be duplicating this every day.

We know it is the Father's will that none should perish. So that means it is His will that the unsaved ones of ours for whom our heart is burdened should be saved. It is also His will that our saved loved ones who are living out of fellowship with the Father should be restored fully to that fellowship. It is only our failure to walk by faith and not by sight that delays the fulfillment of these heart desires of ours. Faith can and will do it. Our faith will create in them an unquenchable longing to know the Father, and it will be so great that it will turn them to Him. "All things are possible to him that believeth."

We can learn to walk by faith and not by sight, if we want to. We are not the least bit different from other people who do. It seems difficult, if not impossible at first, just as walking seems difficult and impossible to the baby that hasn't yet walked. We take a step at a time, and as we progress it becomes much easier. Then it becomes the most natural thing in the world to the child of God. One who walks by faith never returns to the very poor and unsatisfactory way of walking by sight.

As the baby looks to his parents with waiting arms and so knows that he will get to the embrace of those arms, and just does it, by walking, so we look to Jesus and His Word. They create in us the needed faith. The secret of walking by faith and not by sight is to be found in much meditation upon the Word of God.

When He called Johnson to go to Africa, the mission boards wouldn't take him.

He said—"But Jesus Christ has called me."

Finally some one gave him the money to go.

He went to a place that was an English station—where slaves that had been on the slave ships were dumped.

They couldn't get back to their own tribes, and there they were, living lower than they ever had been.

There was nothing so immoral and dirty as that place.

This young man went there and in eighteen months he had more than three hundred men and women saved.

In five years there had been thousands saved, churches built, and missionaries sent to the interior.

There was nothing to equal it in the history of missions.

In this story there is a truth that is of infinite value to us. Is your case the call of Christ?

If it is, you simply can't fail.

J. Hudson Taylor heard a voice say, "If you will walk with me, we will evangelize inland China."

He answered and said, "Who am I, and what can I do?"

He said, "I have no money or friends with money."

When he first went into the work he went out under a Board, but it wasn't satisfactory, and finally he decided to go back and trust God alone.

He held a great meeting in London to interest the people in the work he was undertaking.

**FACTS ABOUT  
TOBACCO**

ROSS G. JONES

Amurath IV, Sultan of Turkey in 1625, prohibited smoking as an unnatural and irreligious custom under pain of death.

Tobacco was prohibited by a penal law of Persia in 1590. Smoking is excessive now in Turkey, but at one time a Turk caught in the act of smoking was conducted in ridicule through the streets with a pipe transfixed through his nose. In Russia where people smoke excessively now, the second offense in smoking was punishable with death. In Switzerland war was waged against the obnoxious American weed. In 1653 to smoke in Berne, Switzerland, was regarded as a crime next to adultery.

Three drops of nicotine placed upon the shaven skin of a cat's back will put a cat to sleep in twenty minutes, eight drops of nicotine will kill a horse in four minutes. Death has been produced by breathing tobacco smoke.

Nicotine is but one of the deadly poisons of tobacco. Acrolin, a most deadly poison to brain and nerve tissue, is formed by the burning of the cigarette. Carbon monoxide gas is another deadly poison. There are nineteen definite poisons which eat at the tissues and overload the blood stream of the cigarette smoker. These are the poisons that give you that "lift" so often spoken of over the air.

Because of these poisons tobacco companies prosper. They sell these poisons, caring little as to the harm done to the user of cigarettes. Do you suppose the people would buy and smoke cigarettes or use tobacco in any form if they knew the virulent poisons it contains?
