## HOW DO WE GET OUR HEALING

E. W. Kenyon

This is a living problem in the hearts of multitudes of people. We know now that healing is in Redemption.

If it is in Redemption, it belongs to every child of God. It is not a problem of faith. The problem of faith confronted the unsaved man when he was seeking an entrance into the family of God. When he believed that Jesus died for his sins according to scripture and made confession of Jesus as Savior and Lord, he came into the family. When he came into the family, healing belonged to him.

You remember the story of Jesus and the Syro-Phoenician woman who came to the Master and pled with Him to heal her child.

He apparently turned her down. She became desperate. Then He said to her, "Don't you understand that you are a Gentile and that healing belongs to the children of Israel? It is not right to give the bread of the children to dogs."

She said, "Yes, Master, but the dogs pick up the crumbs that the children drop."

The Master turned and said, "Healing is yours."

In other words, healing is the bread of the children.

It is to the family what bread is to the children.

Healing belongs to us. Just as care and protection and love, and the answer to our prayers belong to the children, so does healing.

It is not a problem of faith. We passed the problem of faith when we entered the door, the New Birth, into the family of God. Now all things belong to us.

"How will He not with Him freely give us all things." This is the language He uses to the family.

What are the conditions of healing?

First, let us consider the conditions of receiving freedom from sin.

1 Peter 2:24, "Who His own self bare our sins in His Body upon the tree, that we having died unto sin might live unto Righteousness, by whose stripes ye were healed."

He bore our sins in His body on the tree. That is, when He was nailed to the cross. God laid our sins upon Him then.

"Him who knew no sin, God made to become sin."

When He became sin, He was judged with our judgment, and He paid the price of our transgressions and our sin.

When He had satisfied the claims of justice, God justified Him, and when He Justified Him we were Justified in Him.

He died to sin. He died on the ground that He had become our sin substitute. So we died with Him. We were utterly identified with Him.

His death was our death. His suffering was our suffering. We are free from sin.

He was raised because God had Justified us in Him. His Justification was our Justification.

He was made Righteous, but He was made sin first. After He had paid the penalty of sin, then He was made Righteous.

He was made so Righteous that He entered into the Father's presence and sat down there as our Savior and Lord without any taint of sin upon Him.

He sat there as though He had never been made sin.

receive Eternal Life, we become the Righteousness of God in Him. He was made sin that we might become the Righteousness of God in Him.

If He was made sin, it was with our sin. He put that sin away by the sacrifice of Himself.

Then God made Him Righteous. That Righteousness is our Righteousness.

When you accept Him as your Savior and confess Him as your Lord, you become the Righteousness of God in Him.

You stand before the Father just as Jesus stands.

What a standing that is. How little the church has understood it.

We are not poor, weak, miserable sinners. No! We are the very sons and daughters of God Almighty

We are as Righteous as the Righteousness of God can make us. We have a right to healing on the same basis.

I maintain my confession of healing. My confession is His Word.

His Word is now my confession before the world.

I declare that, "By His stripes I am healed."

This belongs to the person who knows that the Word cannot fail and who acts upon it fearlessly.

We ask you to pray definitely with us for these needs. Our prayer circle in the office meets each morning at 8 a. m. Join with us in real intercession and we know that no force of hell will be able to stand against us.

We thank the Father that in Him "We are more than Conquerors!" We know who and what we are... we know that "Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world."

## CONQUERING SATAN AND DISEASE

When Jesus came down from the wilderness where He had been tempted of the devil, He began to cast out demons and heal the sick.

He showed the intimate relation of Satan to disease.

Paul, speaking of this in Acts 10:38 said, "Jesus of Nazareth, whom God anointed with the Holy Spirit and power, who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil, for God was with Him."

Jesus recognized that sickness, disease and insanity came from one common source and to that end He came to destroy the works of the adversary.

The very word "Redemption" has enwrapped within it the thought of deliverance from an enemy. He came to Redeem us from Satan's dominion and power.

He said, "All authority has been given unto me in Heaven and on earth. Go, therefore, and in my Name ye shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. Ye shall cast out demons."

You can see that healing and demon control were linked together by the Master.

Jesus gave us authority over all the dominion of the enemy by the use of His Name.

Satan is the author of disease.

Lu. 13:10-17. Here is a picture of a woman who had a spirit of infirmity for 18 years, and she was bowed together and could not lift herself. "And when Jesus saw her, he called her, and said to her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. And He laid His hands upon her; and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. And the ruler of the synagogue, being moved with indignation because Jesus had healed on the sabbath, answered and said to the multitude, There are six days in which men ought to work; in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the day of the sabbath." But Jesus answered, "Ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan had bound, lo, these eighteen years, to have been loosed from this bond?"

This needs no exposition.

The truth lies on the surface. Disease is of the adversary and healing is of God.

Heb. 2:14 tells us that Jesus conquered the adversary.

Col. 2:15 describes the combat. It tells us that Jesus actually entered into the very realm of the adversary and He put off from Himself the principalities and the powers and He made a show of them openly triumphing over them.

After He had conquered Satan, defeated him, He arose from the dead.

Rev. 1:18: "I am He that was dead, and behold I am alive forever more. And I have the keys of death and of Hades."

Keys represent authority and dominion. Jesus had taken dominion away from the adversary.

He had conquered him and when He arose from the dead, healing belonged to us.

If Jesus was raised from the dead, disease and sin have been put away, and we need no longer be the subjects of sin, or the subjects of disease.

"By His stripes we are healed." When Jesus hung on the cross, God laid upon Him our iniquity and our diseases.

He was made sick with our sickness. He was made sin with our sin.

Now when He arose from the dead it means Satan has been

# IS JESUS ISRAEL'S MESSIAH?

But the next title is the most suggestive and beautiful title: "The Prince of Peace."

There has never been any peace in the world since the fall of man.

Selfishness has been the motive force that has governed the human race. We have been slow to grasp it, but there was never any justice for common people on the earth until Shiloh came.

I don't know whether your heart can take it in or not, but there was never any love. The only thing that ruled the world was Might, and Might was Right.

No one could question the right of Might any more than they can question Stalin's dominion in Russia.

But here comes someone with a new thing—peace that passeth understanding. "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give unto you; not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful."

There was no peace in the world. There was no safety, there was no love, there was no justice, there was no right.

Satan ruled without opposition. What a work God had to perform to establish peace in the earth. It has never been established.

Two or three times we thought that peace had arrived, and then war has broken out again. Today peace seems farther away than ever before.

I wonder if your heart grasps the situation? Peace is the product of love. We mean by love the new kind of love that Jesus brought, agapa, that seeketh not its own, that never seeks to take advantage of the weak. The strong bear the burdens of the weak without any thought of themselves.

That was never in the world until Shiloh came. Jesus brought that new kind of love. Eternal life gave birth to love, and Jesus said, "I am come that ye may have life (zoe), and have it abundantly."

What is this strange new thing called life? It is the nature of the Father. There had never been any zoe in the world before. There had been psuche, the human life. And this new kind of love brought forth a new kind of love, agapa, and that new kind of love gave the world its first joy.

The force that had ruled the world was selfishness.

Selfishness is born of spiritual death, the nature of the devil. Until one grasps the significance of this, the great basic facts of Revelation will be vague and indefinite.

But you know that there are two major forces dominating the world, Satan and God. Spiritual death is the nature of Satan, and spiritual life is the nature of the Father.

Out of spiritual death has come selfishness, with all its train of woes and agonies.

Out of spiritual life has come love, joy, peace.

These two forces are antagonistic to each other.

Israel's Messiah brought eternal life, and faced the devil and his awful force of spiritual death.

Read Isa. 11:1-5: "And there shall come forth a shoot out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots shall bear fruit. And the Spirit of Jehovah shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Jehovah. And his delight shall be in the fear of Jehovah; and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither decide after the hearing of his ears; but with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth; and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. And righteousness shall be the girdle of his waist, and faithfulness the girdle of his loins."

I just want you to notice two or three outstanding facts of this great scripture.

"There shall come forth a shoot out of the stock of Jesse." Who is Jesse? He is David's father.

"And a branch out of his roots shall bear fruit." What does he mean? The Davidic family has not produced a king for hundreds of years. But he is saying that out of this root of David, out of that old dead stump, is going to spring a sapling.

Do you remember Isaiah 53? "He grew up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground."

Get a picture of the stump. It has been dead for hundreds of years, still standing there amid the storms, but it is dead. Apparently it is rotting. The bark is falling off. And then out from those dead roots a child is born:

"Unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given." It is a national child. It grows out of a national root. The Spirit of Jehovah will rest upon Him. The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might.

This is the finest photograph that we have of Jesus in the entire Word.

Notice Him carefully now. There is wisdom and understanding, there is counsel and might, there is knowledge and the revelation of Jehovah—the blending of divine grace, wisdom and love, and that is what we saw in the Man in His earth walk.

Notice another side glance: "He shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither decide after the hearing of his ears."

All men have decided issues and questions by their senses, but this man is going to be guided not by his five senses, the sense knowledge, but by His Spirit.

"With righteousness shall he judge the poor." We have passed over that carelessly. That is the first time that the poor ever had a righteous judgment.

"He shall smite the earth, or the land, with the rod of his mouth; and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked." That is not done yet. That belongs to the reign of glory and majesty at His return. Then "the earth shall be full of knowledge of Jehovah, as the waters cover the sea." That can't be until He returns.

But I do want you to notice this: that the earth walk of the Man of Galilee gave us a vivid picture of perfect wisdom, of perfect peace, of perfect love. It was utterly new to the world.

Perfect justice—there had never been any in the world.

Perfect righteousness—there had never been any righteousness before.

Perfect love—that stranger thing had come to the earth. But they nailed it to the cross. They didn't want it.

Selfishness couldn't brook agapa. The nearest definition that one can get from the Pauline epistles of selfishness is "aut hades"—"self hell."

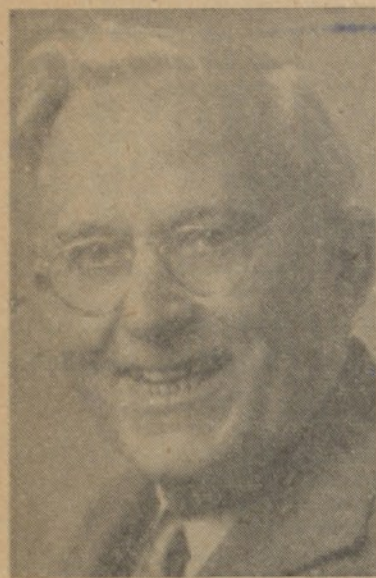
