He Is At Rest

Ruth A. Kenyon

On March 19, 1948, at 12 noon, my dear father, Dr. E. W. Kenyon, went home to be with his Lord. He was eighty years of age.

Dad was born in Saratoga County, New York, the fourth son of a family of ten. When he was in his teens, the family moved to Amsterdam, New York, in the Mohawk Valley. He grew up in Amsterdam, studied at Amsterdam Academy, and at the age of 19 preached his first sermon in the Methodist Church there.

From his earliest days, Dad had a thirst for knowledge, and what he learned he wanted to pass on to others. That desire for study was the driving force in his life. When a young boy, he felt the call to the ministry and though he had to go to work in the carpet mills as a weaver at the age of 15, every spare minute was devoted to study.

He worked his way through school, attended various schools in New Hampshire and Emerson College of Oratory in Boston, Mass. Always he had one fixed goal . . . to preach the gospel, to "study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, handling aright the word of truth." 2 Tim. 2:15.

He was pastor of several churches in the New England States; at the age of thirty he founded and was president of Bethel Bible Institute at Spencer, Mass. (This school has since been moved to Providence, R. I. and is known as Providence Bible Institute.)

Through his ministry at Bethel, hundreds of young men and women were trained and ordained for the ministry, and are now out preaching the Word in all parts of the world.

For over twenty years he traveled in evangelistic work in the East, and was known far and wide. Thousands were saved and healed in these services.

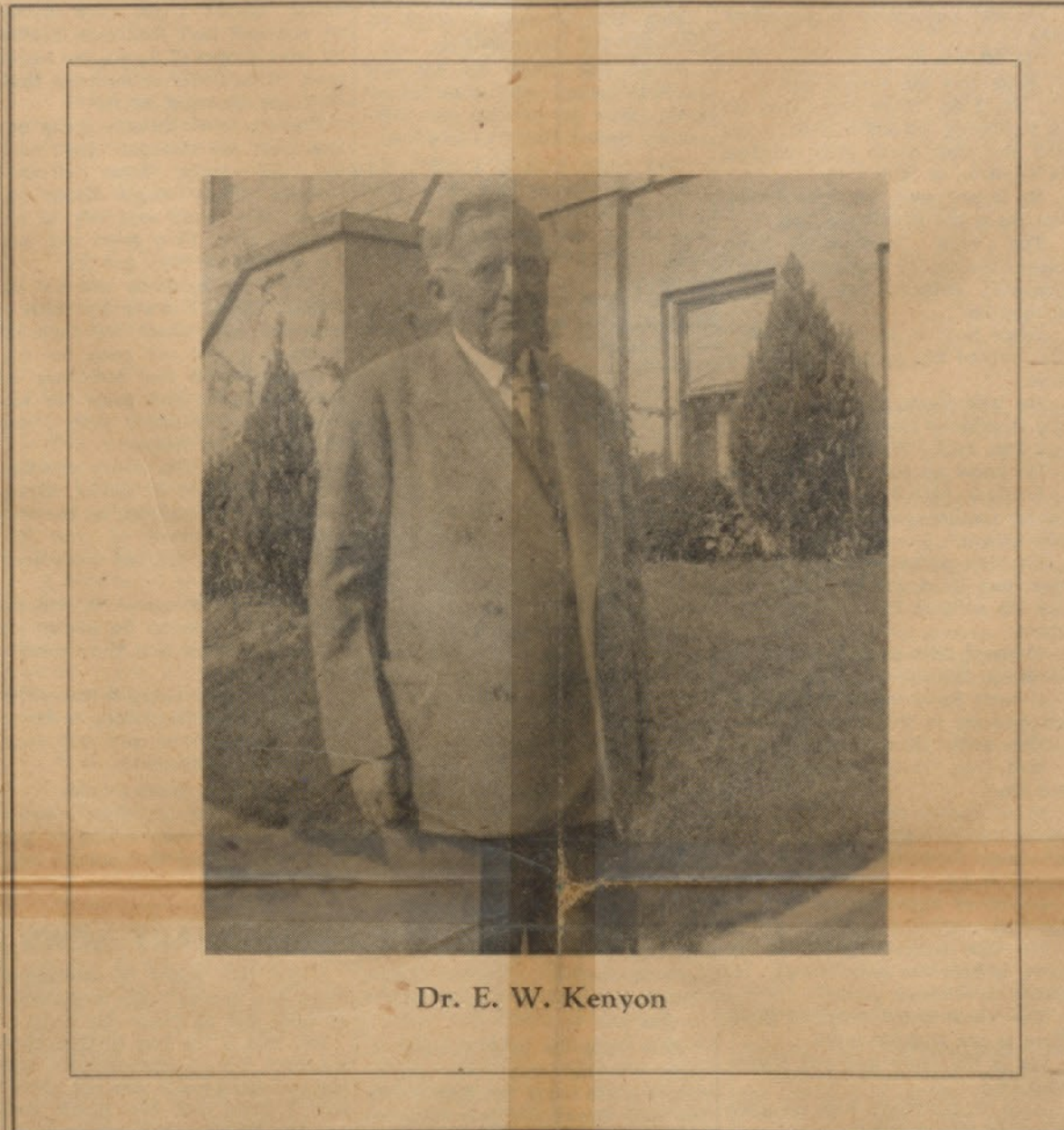
In 1923 he left the East and came to California where he also traveled in evangelistic work. He was pastor of a church in Los Angeles for several years and was one of the pioneers of radio work on the Pacific Coast.

Seventeen years ago he came to the Northwest, and for many years his morning broadcast, "Kenyon's Church of the Air," was an inspiration and blessing to thousands.

He founded "The New Covenant Baptist Church" here in Seattle, and for many years was its pastor.

During the busy years of his ministry he found time to write and publish fourteen books, hundreds of poems and songs (some of which have never been published), correspondence courses and tracts. At the time of his death he had material assembled for twelve additional books, and one was ready for publication. He left hundreds of articles and sermons which have never yet been published.

Shortly before his passing, he had a premonition that he would not be here long, and he called me and said he felt I was the one to carry on his work. He said, "Ruth, dear, I have a feeling I won't be with you much longer.

This work must go on. It is up to you now. You have been looking after it all these years, and with the help of the Lord, I know you can carry on." I promised him I would.

This work which he started must continue to bless untold thousands as it has in the past. Our work is now reaching to all corners of the world. Our circulation has increased to nearly 20,000 in the last few months. There has never been a time when the world needed this message as it does now.

It is only through your prayers and support that this ministry can continue. The Lord has shown us very definitely that it is His will that this message goes forth.

The days that lie ahead may be trying ones, but we know that He is our sufficiency, and in Him "We are more than conquerors."

I came in contact with the ministry of Dr. Kenyon some ten years ago by hearing him over the radio. It has been my privilege to be directly or indirectly under his ministry since that time.

It was with sorrow and joy that we witnessed the laying away of his earthly tabernacle. Joy because we know that he has gone to be with the Lord, and sorrow because we no longer have the joy of his fellowship in person.

Dr. Kenyon had a long and fruitful ministry of over fifty years, and he will live on in the hearts of those who knew him and in the literature which he labored so hard to leave in the hands of posterity.

I am sure that the Lord welcomed his coming as one of his great Generals in the Faith. Paul wrote to Timothy, "Fight the good fight of Faith," and again, "Be ye a good soldier of the Lord Jesus Christ," and "Well done, thou good and faithful servant—enter thou into the joy of the Lord."

Dr. Kenyon was known as a teacher of teachers. Over the air he was known as the "Faith Builder." Through his ministry of the Word men and women were made pleasing to God. What a challenge that is to every Christian worker. Many a young minister and worker has been given a start, inspiration and encouragement through the friendly advice and council of Dr. Kenyon. He

knew the secret of a successful ministry. He was an early riser, and through his communion with the Lord he was able to help and build others up. He had love and encouragement for all. The only enemy he recognized was the Devil and his helpers. But he knew how to deal with them in the Name of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Dr. Kenyon knew the secret of Divine Love. He loved men and women into the Kingdom of God, and then built the Word into them so they could stand victoriously. It was Dr. Kenyon who said, "I would rather die than be a failure. You are a success because you are tied up with omnipotence. God never made a failure. You have the life of God. You have his ability and strength."

Dr. Kenyon was a master of words. To me he was the most forceful and powerful speaker that I have ever witnessed behind the pulpit. His messages from the Word of God were always fresh and packed with Divine dynamite.

He was a pioneer in radio work on the West coast. This ministry has had a far reaching effect on the Church. Thousands, here in the Northwest and no doubt millions the world over, through his writings have felt the impact of this man's ministry. Truly he was a great ambassador for the Lord Jesus Christ.

Dr. Kenyon was a faithful minister of the Word of God. He was never known to be late for an appointment or service. His faith-

He has gone to be with his Lord, to enjoy the glories of heaven. He leaves behind vast God-given treasures of spiritual blessings for us to enjoy while he goes to the sure reward that awaits the faithful minister. I count it a rare privilege to have known him and to have had the joy of his fellowship. May the Lord bless his memory to your hearts.

He not only put sin away by the sacrifice of Himself, but He made provision whereby sins could be dealt with also.

When you accept Jesus as your Savior and confess Him as your Lord, everything you have ever done in the past stops being.

You stand before the Father as though you had never sinned.

He was manifested to take away sins.

"In Him is no sin."
Jesus was the sinless one.

1 Jn. 2:29, "If ye know that He is righteous, ye know that every one also that doeth righteousness is begotten of Him."

He is not only the sinless One, but He is the Righteous One.

The word "Righteous" here means the ability to stand in God's presence without any sin consciousness.

Jesus is now as He was when He walked the earth, the sinless One.

He was then, and He is now, the Righteous One.

1 Pet. 2:22, "Who did no sin."
He knew no sin. He did no sin.

Is. 53:9, "He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth."

He was perhaps the only man who has lived, whose mouth did not sin against His body and His spirit.

Twice it tells us that there was no sin in His lips.

I don't know of anything that gripped me as this did.

Heb. 4:15, "He was without sin."
Heb. 7:26, "Holy, guileless, without sin."

It is a remarkable thing that Jesus had no ax to grind. He had no reason for being otherwise than what He was.

He never appeared to be what He was not.

He was without guile. If He were a business man today, He would be without guile.

The whole world is full of guile. Here is one without guile.

He is the Holy and the Righteous One.

Acts 3:14, "There was no guile found in His mouth."

Jesus stands utterly alone back there in the age in which He lived. But now He is not alone. He is one with us.

The reason why Jesus had no guile, the reason why His mouth never sinned against Him, was because He walked in love.

I don't know of anything that can bring such conviction upon careless speaking as the fact that Jesus walked in Love.

He walked differently than other people.

That is what Jesus was.

WHAT JESUS BECAME

Rom. 8:3 "For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending His own son in the likeness of sinful flesh, condemned sin in the flesh."

Gal. 3:13, the Holy One became accursed for us.

Rom. 3:25, He was made a propitiation for our sins.

"Whom God set forth to be a propitiation on the ground of His blood."

Jesus actually became one with man.

When He was nailed to the cross, He actually became one with man in all his weakness and failings, his sin, his diseases, his captivity to Satan, his subjection to the forces of darkness.

He became one with us on the cross.

Humanity has never been so low but what Jesus went a step below it.

"Him who knew no sin God made to become sin with our sins."

He was stricken, smitten of God.

1 Jn. 2:2, He is our substitute.
1 Jn. 4:10, "Herein is love, not

that we loved God but He loved us and sent His Son to be the substitute for our sins."

God so loved that He gave. He so loved that He made His Son sin on our behalf until Jesus cried, "My God, my God why hast thou forsaken me."

The human mind cannot grasp it. Heb. 2:17, "Wherefore it behooved Him in all things to be made like unto His brethren."

Then He became like they were when they called for His crucifixion.

He became like the worst Jews. How deep He sank to reach us. Now you can appreciate it.

"Him who knew no sin God made to become sin." Man did not make Him to become sin. Man merely nailed Him to the cross.

God made Him to become sin. Is. 53: "All we like sheep had gone astray. We had turned every one to his own way and the Lord hath laid upon Him the iniquity of us all."

The word "iniquity" drips with awfulness. It is the very essence of badness.

He laid upon Him the iniquity, the foul smelling hideous thing.

He put sin away. He not only suffered it, He not only became sin, but He put it away.

He went down into the place where the sinner should have gone. He met every requirement of justice.

He actually put sin away by the sacrifice of Himself.

After He went down into that place of suffering and had satisfied the claims of justice, He was made alive in spirit, as every sinner can be made alive.

Then He was Justified, declared Righteous.

When Jesus came out of hell He ascended into heaven and stood in the presence of the Father without any sense of guilt or inferiority.

Jesus could actually stand in the Father's presence as though sin had never touched Him. As sure as Jesus sits on the throne that same thing is true in regard to you and to me.

How little we have grasped it. He was not only made Righteous but He made the New Birth, the New Creation a possibility so that you and I may be made New Creations.

We become New Creations, the Righteousness of God in Him. We become the sons and daughters of God by nature.

Jn. 5:23, "That all may honor the Son, even as they honor the Father."

When Jesus sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, He had answered every demand of Justice. He had answered every cry of the heart of the Father. He had met every need of man.

When He had satisfied the claims of justice, the heart claims of God, the demands of humanity, He sat down at the right hand of God.

If that be true, modern Christianity has gone far astray.

We can imagine that we are there before the throne with the Father and Jesus and the angels. Suddenly from the earth there comes a cry, "Oh God be merciful to me a sinner."

Then we see him rush to the altar for forgiveness. God turns to Jesus and says, "Son I thought I put that man's sin upon you and you became answerable for him."

Before Jesus could speak, an angel said, "They are not responsible for it. They do not understand their Redemption."

Then there comes a cry from a Believer, one of God's own children asking for strength to overcome some temptation. Again the Father whispers, "Son I thought you were the strength of their lives. I thought I sent the Holy Spirit to dwell in them."

Again the angel answers, "Can't you understand they do not know the Word, they don't understand

yet that you laid their weakness, their sins, everything on Jesus."

Then a Christian cries, "Oh God forgive me." The Father says, "Didn't I appoint you, Son, as the advocate of these people?"

Again the angel answered, "They are ignorant of the Word. They have never yet seen their place."

Then comes the cry of a cancer case: "Oh God heal me. Why don't you heal me? I have prayed and prayed and God doesn't hear my prayer."

Once more the Father says to Jesus, "Didn't I put that cancer on you and isn't that man healed by your stripes?" Again the angel says, "Don't you understand that they are ignorant of it."

The cry is continually going up, this man for strength, that man for deliverance from circumstances. Every single thing for which they pray and cry is already theirs. They need not ask for it. How do they get it?
