Norval Mission Lecturer will  
speak in Guymon

OCTOBER 22 AND 23

at the

High School Auditorium



Rev. Parham will tell of the Pal-  
estine country.

Rev. Parham, Evangelist and Lec-  
turer will be presenting two hun-  
dred pictures of the Holy Land.

He has just recently returned  
from Palestine where he has been  
engaged in research work. He  
shows one hundred pictures each  
evening, taking one and one-half  
hours to explain them.

Reverend Parham is an interest-  
ing speaker. The pictures are both  
interesting and instructive. Pictures  
will be different each evening. A  
New York paper said the collection  
of pictures brought from the Holy  
Land is the best ever brought to  
this country. They were secured  
and developed through a process  
that brings out the subject matter  
in life-like form, one of them show-  
ing the evangelist baptizing in the  
River Jordan.

The evangelist has shown these  
pictures in many cities in the U. S.  
A. and at all appearances he has  
had large audiences.

There is no charge for the lec-  
tures. The services will be at 7 P.  
each evening.
