## OUR CONFESSION

Frances E. Phalen

The word "confession" is often used in the New Testament, but there is much misunderstanding of the term because there are several kinds of Confession. The four kinds mentioned are: (1) The Confession of the Covenant Jew under Law, (2) The Confession of the sinner today, (3) The Confession of the believer out of fellowship, and (4) The Confession of our faith in the Word of God.

### The Confession of the Covenant Jew Under Law

The Confession of the Covenant Jew under Law was a Confession of sins. John the Baptist was the forerunner of the Messiah, and his mission was to "prepare the way of the Lord." Math. 3:1-7. These backslidden people were in no condition to welcome the Lord, so he preached a Gospel of Repentance, which included Confession of sins, restitution, and water baptism. In confessing their sins they saw the sinfulness of their lives and the need of reformation that they might be fit to receive Him.

### The Confession of the Sinner Today

Repentance under the Law meant Confession of sins. Repentance under Grace means the acceptance of the Lord Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord. The nearest they could come to Salvation, under the Law, was to see their need and be willing to accept God's remedy for it. Their sorrow for sin was shown by their making restitution. Repentance, under Grace, means the acceptance of that remedy, the Lord Jesus Christ. Sorrow for sin is shown by allowing Him to be Lord. It is not necessary for the sinner today to confess his sins, because his need is not one of reformation. His need is to receive a new Lord. This he does by confessing Jesus as Lord of his life. Rom. 10:9-10.

### The Confession of the Believer Out of Fellowship

When the one outside of Christ appropriates the Finished Work of Christ, he is made alive. Eph. 2:1. His spirit is recreated, but his mind remains unchanged. It is this unrenowned mind, which hasn't yet learned to obey the Word, that causes acts of disobedience. These sins destroy his fellowship with the Father, and must be confessed to Him. The moment they are confessed, they are forgiven and forgotten. 1 Jn. 1:9.

### The Confession of Our Faith in the Word

In Tim. 6:12 Christianity is called a Confession. "Fight the good fight of the faith, lay hold on the life eternal, whereunto thou wast called, and didst confess the good confession in the sight of many witnesses."

The child of God who desires to grow spiritually, believes and continually confesses faith in God's Word.

There is a power in words that make them of vital importance to the believer. "But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of Faith, which we preach." Rom. 10:8.

Faith is a heart and mouth confirmation of the Word of God. We make known our faith in God and in His Word, by our words. It is not enough to say that we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ; we must confess His Lordship over our lives. Nor is it enough to say that we believe the Bible; we must confess its truths in the face of every conflicting appearance.

Rev. 12:11 "And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb, and because of the word of their testimony . . ." This has

### WALKING IN LOVE

E. W. Kenyon

When Jesus came He brought a new kind of love to the world.

He brought a great many new things, but He brought nothing to compare with this love, unless it was the new kind of life that has had such a phenomenal influence upon humanity.

When Jesus came, the word for "love" in the classical Greek was "Phileo!"

He introduced the word "Agapa".

Trent declared that this word "Agapa" was born in the bosom of revelation. In other words, it is evident that Jesus coined it.

Someone says, "The word 'Agapa' was used in the Septuagint translation of the Old Testament, translated 280 years B.C." That is true, but we have not the original copies of that translation. They have been copied and recopied scores, even hundreds of times.

The oldest copies that we have are 700, 800, or 900 years after Christ. It is evident that the word "Agapa" crept into that Septuagint translation. Our translators call it "an interpolation". You cannot find the word "Agapa" in classical Greek before Christ's time. That led Bishop Trent to believe that it was coined by Jesus.

I have come to that conclusion, too.

What does "Agapa" mean? If you want to get the definition, turn to the 13th chapter of 1st Corinthians.

If you want the contrast between the two words, turn to the 21st chapter of John, that little dialogue of Jesus with Peter after Jesus arose from the dead. Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, lovest thou me more than these?" (Agapa-est)

Peter said, "Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I 'Phileo' thee."

Jesus said to him, "Feed my lambs."

He said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, 'Agapa-est' thou me?"

And Peter answered, "Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I 'Phileo' thee."

Then Jesus comes to Peter's level, and He says: "Simon, son of John, 'Phileo-est' thou me?"

Peter, grieved, says "Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I 'Phileo' thee."

Here is the contrast: Peter did not Agapa Jesus until after the day of Pentecost. Then he loved Jesus and gave himself up for Jesus, dying on the cross with his head downward.

Jesus said, "A new commandment I give unto you, That ye 'Agapa' one another, even as I have 'Agapaed' you—By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have 'Agapa' one to another."

This is the law of the New Covenant that Jesus gave us in His own blood.

In 1 John 4:7,8 "God is 'Agapa'." Now you understand it. "Phileo" is the love of the natural, fallen man, the goddess of the divorce court. A man loves a woman today enough to die for her, and tomorrow because he is jealous of her he drives a dagger into her heart. "Phileo" love is the best thing that fallen man has, but it has failed to stand the test of human life. It has broken down.

The thing that the world needs is this Jesus kind of love, this new kind of love.

## RIGHT AND WRONG THINKING

Our conduct is largely made up of past thinking.

Our conversation, our real conversation is the product of past thinking.

I cannot think deeply and long without my thoughts materializing into actions and words.

Then if I think wrong, there will be a corresponding wrong action and wrong words.

If I think sickness and meditate on sickness and fill my spirit with fear of T. B. or a cancer or some other disease, I will be sure to speak of it and when I speak of it, my words are built back into me.

We know now that we can think a cancer in our own body.

We can think it until fear reproduces that dread disease in our blood stream.

Then we should discipline ourselves to think healthy thoughts.

You think of your weakness and inability, and you will go down to the level of it.

You think of what God is in you and what you can do in Christ, you whisper this over and over again, "I can do all things in Him who strengtheneth me," or who is my strength, and you keep repeating that and you will rise to the level of it.

You will be doing the impossible things.

When He says, "They that believe shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover," you say, "I am a believer, I am a child of God, then I can lay hands on the sick and they will be healed."

You meditate on it.

Never for one minute admit that that Word cannot be made real in your life and you will come to the level of it.

"By His stripes, ye were healed." I would change it, "By His stripes I am healed." I do not admit that that Word can be broken.

I admit that I may have delusions and I may not understand myself or my body, but I do know the Word of God is true and cannot be any other way than what He says.

"By His stripes I am healed." That is an absolute statement of fact. I am healed.

The pains I had, I haven't; the cold I had, I haven't; the indigestion I had is a thing of the past. I will not even think of it.

"Perfect love casts out fear." That fear that I had of such a person has stopped being for fear is cast out by Love and now I Love that person.

They have done me a great injury perhaps but I love them.

No one can injure me if I love them whole-heartedly.

If I love my enemies, I pull their teeth, I trim their claws. They cannot bite me, they cannot scratch me because I love them.

"Agapa" is the solution of the home problem, the solution of the economic problem. "Agapa" is the very badge of Christianity.

In 1 John 3:14 "We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not, abideth in death."

You see that love is the test of our relationship. The man that does not walk in love has no proof that he has been Born Again.

In 1 John 4:8 "he that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love."

"Every one that loveth is begotten of God, and knoweth God," 1 John 4:7, so if you do not love you have never been Born Again. This is God's test.

## Established in Righteousness

Isaiah 54:14

This follows the great substitu-  
tionary chapter, Isaiah 53, and this  
is the statement:

"In righteousness shalt thou be  
established."

If the heart can be established  
in righteousness, the faith problem  
is solved.

Healing becomes a certainty; for  
if you begin to think of yourself  
as the righteousness of God, you  
know that the righteousness of  
God cannot have a cancer or tuber-  
culosis; that no disease could fas-  
ten itself upon the righteousness  
of God.

If you learn to visualize yourself  
as the "righteousness of God," as  
a very son, a very daughter, of  
God Almighty, a joint-heir with  
Jesus Christ, on terms of utter  
equality with Him; if you get it in  
your mind clearly as you go about  
your business, or in your home, or  
when you are walking on the  
street, and you keep whispering it  
to yourself until it becomes a part  
of your daily consciousness, that  
you are the righteousness of God  
and that God is your Righteous-  
ness—there is no problem that this  
will not solve.

Healing is as simple as eating.  
Prayer becomes an unconscious  
joy, a simple communion with Him.  
The old dread and fear and sense  
of inferiority are gone.

In Isaiah 32:17 He declares,  
"And the work of righteousness  
shall be peace; and the effect of  
righteousness, quietness and confi-  
dence for ever."

You see, the work of Righteous-  
ness has brought peace to your  
heart.

You have peace with God  
through our Lord Jesus Christ.

You have peace of mind.

You have a sense of tranquility  
and rest.

The old struggle is over.

You are now resting quietly.

You are no longer anxious.

You know that you and the  
Father are on terms of absolute in-  
timacy, because He has given you  
His own nature.

You keep whispering to your-

Holiness; made out of God, Him-  
self.

We were created in Christ Jesus.  
We are the workmanship of God.  
God did it.

"Now the effect of righteousness  
is peace, quietness, and assurance  
forever."

It is the highest order of faith.

It is unconscious faith.

It is the highest order of confi-  
dence.

It is a sweet, quiet assurance  
born of the knowledge that Satan  
has no ability to conquer you.

You say, "I am a New Creation,  
created in Christ Jesus. I am a

The whole background of this  
thing has to be in your mind, a

ure, rather than rejoicing in the  
strength of our Lord.

We have had our eyes on our  
weaknesses.

We have contemplated our fail-  
ures.

We have thought of what weak  
folks we are, what unworthy folks.

We have kept that before our  
minds until we have gone to the  
level of it.

You will walk the streets with  
the consciousness of your place in  
Christ.

Come, let us live what we are.

You are what God made you.

Now rejoice in it!

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**THE ABUNDANT LIFE**

Emma Eliason

As we study the Scriptures we come to know that Eternal Life is the nature of God and that this new nature is possessed by every child of God.

In the Greek there are three words translated life. These words are Zoe, Psuche and Bios. Understanding the full meaning of these words gives a greater appreciation of what we possess and so makes life richer and fuller.

"Zoe" means Eternal Life. To most believers this word merely means everlasting life. Zoe does have that meaning to it for Eternal Life is everlasting; however, there is so much more to possessing Eternal Life than simply knowing that we will live forever.

John 10:10 tells us that Jesus came to bring life (Zoe) and that abundantly. John 1:12 tells us that to as many as received Him (Christ) to them He gave the right to become the Sons of God. John 1:1-4 shows us that Jesus and the Word are one and that the Word is life. John 6:63 tells us that the Word is spirit and is life. 2 Peter 1:4 tells us through these promises we become partakers of the Divine nature.

Eternal Life then is a life, a nature imparted by the Holy Spirit to man's spirit when he accepts the Word.

The second word translated life is "Psuche." This is the human life of man.

In the beginning Adam had a perfect human life, possessing neither Eternal Life nor Spiritual Death. He had the offer of Eternal Life extended to him, but he refused it. Instead he partook of Spiritual Death, the nature of Satan. This nature is directly opposite to God's nature in its manifestations. Through Adam's sin man became a partaker of Spiritual Death, and now his body, or his human life, is dominated by sin, or Spiritual Death. As soon as he receives Eternal Life, this changes and Eternal Life dominates his body as well as his soul and spirit.

"Bios" is the third word translated life and means "manner of life." Man's manner of life is determined by whether he is indwelt and ruled by God's nature or by Satan's nature. The two cannot rule at the same time. Matt. 6:24.

On the ground of the Substitutionary work of Christ, when man accepts Christ as Saviour and Lord, he is taken from Satan's dominion and transferred to that of Christ's.

Christ died for man's sin and arose when man was justified or declared righteous. Rom. 4:25. The penalty being therefore paid gives man a standing before God the same as that which was Adam's before he sinned. Thus when man accepts this work done on his behalf, Satan's rule is broken, Spiritual Death is eliminated from his spirit and God's own life and nature, Zoe, is imparted to him.

This does not eliminate the "Psuche" life. It means that man has a new Lord who has made provision for him to become a New Creation by giving Eternal Life to his spirit.

As long as the Christian is in this world there is a two-fold bid for his allegiance, that of God from within his spirit and that of Satan from without. In Gal. 2:20 Paul states, "I have been crucified with Christ, and it is no longer I who live, but Christ liveth in me, and that life which I now live in the flesh, I live in faith in the Son of God." Paul, though living in the flesh, so recognized the Lordship of Christ and was so given over to the walk in the spirit that Christ could live through him.

Man must make the choice, for it is as he wills to obey God that God can work on his behalf, renewing his mind and bringing him into agreement with the perfect will of God, thus transforming his life so that his manner of life becomes totally different from what it would be were he not a Christian.

Both need Eternal Life because they are Spiritually dead.

They need to be recreated, made New Creations, taken out of the family of Satan and "translated into the Kingdom of the Son of His love," where God can guide them and reveal His will to them.

Yes, can we who have received "so great Salvation" and have grasped the realities of the New Covenant, neglect to give it to somebody's child?
