
# Spel shall be preached... Skall the End Come

### A SERMON PREACHED AT THE OPENING OF THE NEW DALLAS REVIVAL CENTER by Evangelist Velmer Gardner

Matthew 24:14—"And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all and then shall the end come."

I'm glad for the wonderful gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus was speaking, as He told His disciples that they were to preach the same gospel that He was preaching. This is the same gospel that we are to preach today . . . because Jesus Christ is the same vesterday, today and forever. We have a job to do. Our job is to preach and His job is to confirm His Gospel. He told His disciples to go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature . . . and He said these signs shall follow them that believe . . . and they went forth everywhere and He went with them confirming the word with signs following. If we will only dare to preach His word in faith, He will never fail us. He will go with us. The same Holy Spirit that anointed Jesus, will anoint you and I as we preach His

One may say, "I can't preach, or I can't testify." Our God can give you the power to do either. Hebrews 1:7 says, "He makes His angels spirits and His ministers FLAMES OF FIRE." We don't have to do it. He does it for us. When God called Moses, He said, "Moses, I have heard the cry of my people. I have seen their afflictions and I am coming down to deliver them out of the hand of Pharaoh." That sounded all right . . . but God said, "Moses, YOU go and bring deliverance to my people." Moses said, "God I can't go I'm not a great orator. I'm slow of speech." God knew all about that already. God said, "Just tell them that the great I AM has appeared unto you." Moses said, "God, they won't believe it." God asked, "Moses, what do you have in your hand? Throw it on the ground!" When Moses threw the staff on the ground, it immediately turned into a serpent. When he picked it up, as God commanded, it became a rod again. God said, "Moses you go. They won't believe you because of your great oratory or your eclesiastical learn-



ing . . . but if you will go they will believe because of the signs, wonders and miracles that will accompany the proclamation of my words! They will know that the great I AM has sent thee!"

My brother, that is exactly what Jesus of Nazareth has called and ordained us to do. WE are to go into all the world and preach the gospel. We are to preach the same gospel that Jesus preached . . . anointed with that same Spirit that Jesus was anointed with. He healed the sick, cleansed the lepers and cast out devils. He raised the dead. He never preached a funeral sermon. He broks up every funeral that He ever attended. The Bible declares that if all the miracles that He performed were written in books there wouldn't be enough room in the world to hold them. He was the SON OF THE LIVING GOD and God wants us to proclaim that message to our generation. Bible days are here again. The Book of Acts is being repeated today! God almighty is moving by His Spirit.

Jesus said, "This gospel shall be preached!" He didn't say that it MIGHT be preached. If I don't preach it, someone else will. If your church won't preach it, others will. It shall be preached! God doesn't need me to preach. I need God. I must depend upon Him. He has about 27 billion people and He can find someone to take my place (and yours).

When Mordecai challenged Esther, he said, "You've come to the kingdom for such a time as this." She wasn't quite sure that she was willing, but her uncle told her that if she wouldn't go, deliverance would arise from another source. My friend, no matter what church you belong to, you must agree that God has raised up the pentecostal movement to bring deliverance to this sin-cursed backslidden world in our day. I am here to tell you that this gospel will be preached in all its fullness. Some old dried-up preacher controlled by a bunch of dead deacons that belong to a dead church will say, "None

of these 'healing' evangelists are going to come into my town!" He is only fooling himself. It will be preached and he will be unable to prevent it. It SHALL be preached. I heard one old 'shriveled' preacher once say, "I'm against this healing ministry. I'll block it." He's like a little bulldog standing on the tracks trying to stop a streamliner. This gospel shall be preached... healing, salvation and deliverance from sin and habits!

God only has one church, no matter what name they tack on the outside of the building. God started one church on the day of Pentecost in the upper room. God has empowered that church

lives in this "miracle" age of television, radio and super-sonic flight) comes into our "ice box" churches and see deaf people, cripples and blind everywhere. They see churches supporting tremendous hospitals and Christians spend. ing millions on doctor and medical bills. They KNOW THAT THIS ISN'T "THAT!" This isn't the power-packed church that Jesus established and empowered. I am here to tell you that the sinner who thinks that is RIGHT. Jesus didn't establish a weak, powerless church. He said these signs shall follow those that believe and if these signs are not following in a church, you may know that they DO NOT BE-

and that church shall prevail over the powers of the devil. The same message that was preached by those Spiritfilled men and women . . . atonement, deliverance, healing and Holy Ghost baptism will go forth because Jesus Christ said that it would . . . and then shall the end come. Some preachers may not be in favor of any portion of the gospel which pertains to healing ... but there will be healings in our day. Peter stood on the day of Pentecost and cried, "This is that!" The pastor of the First Backslidden Church of Jerusalem said, "No, no, this isn't that!" But it was that. Some of the old moss-back pastors today, with their "bored" meetings and their "weakly" prayer meetings deny that there are miracles today. This generation (which

LIEVE! They are not preaching the gospel that Jesus intended them to preach. He did not tell His disciples to preach anything different from the gospel that He preached. He did not tell them to soften or neglect any portion of the good news.

If the pentecostal movement doesn't have the THAT of which Peter was speaking, what is this thing that they have? If this isn't THAT, where is THAT and why don't YOU have it? Why don't you have THAT instead of the "old dead form" that you have? I will keep what I have till you produce that, because it's so much better than what you have!

While I was in Illinois last summer, a prominent Methodist leader and pastor wrote a book entitled "Speaking in

tongues, examined by the scriptures and proven to be of the devil." He had it already to take to the printer. While attending a Methodist convention in southern Illinois, a Methodist deacon who had ventured into one of Oral Roberts' meetings came to him one night and invited him to hear a tape recording of Brother Roberts' sermon on the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Thinking that he might obtain additional material for his book, he consented to go. Five other preachers and their wives were also to hear the recording at the deacon's home. When Brother Roberts had finished preaching, this Methodist leader was upon his knees crying, "Lord, fill me with the Holy Spirit!" By 3 o'clock in the morning God had baptized five Methodist pastors, three deacons and twenty-two young people with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. This Methodist leader spoke in tongues for 51/2 hours. He took the book that he had written and cast it into the fire. He immediately started a new book entitled: "Speaking in tongues, re-examined by the scriptures and proven to be of God."

God will never permit the church that was started by His Son and empowered by His Spirit to be defeated. He is going to rejuvenate and inspire His people with a demonstration of such miraculous power that the world will be amazed. His church will leave this earth with a final display of glorious apostalic manifestations. We have never yet seen even a mild example of God's last day power . . . such as we can expect from this hour in which we live. I can hear the sound of the "going" in the mulberry trees! I can see a cloud the size of a man's hand in the distance. The Lord, omnipotent, shall rend the heavens and come down. He is riding tonight in the chariot of omnipotence. . . . The wonderful councelor, the mighty God and the Prince of Peace, God has come down and He has given gifts unto men. This mighty Gospel shall be preached!

This old sin-sick world needs this message of deliverance. They need to be told of a living Christ who is the same yesterday, today and forever. Some of us are accused of over-emphasizing healing and the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Some of the denominations tell us that we don't need those things any more... but today our hospitals are filled with CHRISTIANS. There is more ungodliness and immorality in the world than ever before. We must have the SUPERNATURAL

Dear Brother Coe:

It was good to hear your voice over the phone last night, so I thought that I would take time to just drop you a line, and tell you about my wife's healing.

Ten years ago when we came to Springfield, we were stern believers in divine healing, taking everything to God, and depending upon man for nothing. As the years went by, and we saw the lack of faith in others, somehow, we just "went along with the crowd."

Just before I left the school, God laid upon our hearts the message of Divine Deliverance, and so as we traveled from church to church, on weekends, and in the summer, we carried the message of Deliverance with us. Then, last March, God led us out into the full time ministry, and we bagan to see things really happen for God, as souls were saved, bodies were healed, and believers received the Holy Spirit.

Last October, right in the midst of God's blessing upon our lives, my wife was taken sick. We then, called a doctor, why, we do not know. The doctor informed us that immediate surgery would be necessary. We were given no time to make a decision, or pray. After four and a half hours in the operating room, we were informed that she had ancer in the most 'advanced stages, and she had about two months to live. We recognized our authority over this isease, so we did not worry, and God impletely delivered.

As she laid in bed, my wife saw the hand of the "Living Christ," as it came, replacing disease ridden, and removed organs. It was complete even to the stripes of Isaiah the fifty-third chapter.

Within a week, she was out of the hospital, and two and a half weeks later, was in the pulpit proclaiming again the message of Deliverance.

Since that time, we have had several meetings, and she has been with us. However, all of this time, the enemy has come and tormented her, sometimes, to a degree that it seems that we could not stand.

Last night, this came to a climax, and at that time we called you. After we finished talking to you on the phone, God promised us complete deliverance from every bit of oppression. He showed us that exactly at 12 o'clock that deliverance would come. Around one minute to 12 she started vomiting, and just as the clock struck 12 the oppression was completely gone! How faithful our Saviour is, to deliver, just when we need it most!

We feel that this oppression has been for ministry, so now we are praising God not only for deliverance, but for the oppression itself. God knows, how many of "His People" are being tormented by satan, and need deliverance.

During our last meeting, in Shreveport, we almost stood back in "awe" as
God moved among us, Many times,
after praying for a few sick folk, we
would give an altar call, and see many
come to the altar for salvation. We saw
all types of sickness, subject to us, in
the name of our Saviour. A Baptist
preacher, even sent one of his members
to be prayed for, telling her that she
would get healed if she would go down
to that "healing meeting"!




# Keep on Knocking!!!

Preached During Opening Service of Dallas Revival Center

St. Luke 18:2-5—"Saying, there was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man: And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of my adversary. And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge said. And shall not God avenge his own elect which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them."

I ask you to get a picture with me of the old judge. He was evidently a calloused man. I can imagine, as I read this scripture, that he had a face like a bulldog. If you have ever received a parking ticket and had to stand before some scowling, pitiless judge, showing no signs of mercy upon his countenance, you can no doubt visualize a similar man. A good judge who has formed his opinion after hearing the evidence will not alter his decision. The Bible says that this old judge feared neither God nor man. He was probably bald-headed, with possibly two or three hairs left upon his scalp . . . which he no doubt prized very highly. I am sure that he kept a bottle of medicine upon his desk for the sour stomach which had developed from his bitter attitude toward life. The Bible says that this little widow kept coming to this judge. No doubt she was afraid of this harsh old man She probably trembled at the thought of having to appear before him again, but the need was great. She was desperate. She said, "Judge, avenge me of my adversaries." That old judge said, "Woman, I have made up my mind and I will not change. My judgment is going to stand." The little widow would not be discouraged! She just kept coming.



After she had come about 60 times, the old judge began to recognize her foot steps as she came down the hall. I can hear that judge as he finally turns to the sheriff and says, "Lock the door. Don't let that woman into this courtroom again!" The sheriff was forced to say, "I can't lock the door, judge. This is an open court and I must permit her to enter."

The Bible says that widow just kept coming! After she had come about 160 times, I can see the judge as he trembles nervously and said, "I can't stand this any longer. That woman is driving me crazy." He reaches up and pulls out the three hairs that he had prized so highly. Suddenly he leans forward and asks, "Woman, what do you want? I can't stand this any longer. What do you want?" The woman said, "I don't want much, judge. I just want you to rid me of my adversary!" The Bible

says that because the woman wearied the unjust judge, he changed his mind and gave her what she had requested. If an old unjust judge will do that for a little widow, how much will God do for His children . . , IF WE JUST KEEP COMING!

Many people come to the church one night for prayer and if the prayer is not answered they don't come back. They say, "I was prayed for, but I didn't get anything." WHO ELSE CAN YOU GO TO? GOD IS THE ONLY ONE WHO CAN HEAL YOU! When the doctors have given up your case as hopeless... you have to go to Him.

In Luke 11:5-10 we read of a man who was in bed with his children. Suddenly a neighbor began to knock at his door at midnight. The man within the house cried out, "What do you want?" The man said, " A friend of mine who



### God is Preparing His People...

Joel 2:25-26 And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I have sent among you. You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied and praise the name of the Lord, your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.

God said He would pour out of His Spirit upon all flesh; sons and daughters would prophesy ... old men dream dreams and young men see visions. Upon his handmaidens and servants He would pour out His Spirit in the last days and they would prophesy. There were three people who went to a large church once who were confronted with problems. They were desparately in need of help. One of them was a young man who had been contemplating a theft. There was a young girl who was thinking of committing sin. It stripped Jesus Christ of His glory and gave them no hope of deliverance. Consequently, the young man stole the money from his employer; the young girl took the step into sin which led to shame and disgrace...and the old man took his life. He had received nothing to make him realize that it is not what a man possesses that is important, but what you have in your heart. He was not told that life does not begin at 40, but at the time you find the Savior.

The church should never send people away with a spiritual hunger. Their needs should be met: Help them to touch their parched lips to the water of life and find satisfaction in Jesus Christ. Ladies and gentlemen, I believe that God is restoring the gifts to the body of Christ throughout the land. Signs are following believers; miracles

and healings are numerous in many churches. God will pour in the oil and his people will praise Him and be satisfied.

Jesus is coming! You can take your newspaper in one hand and the Bible in the other and you can literally see the fulfillment of prophecy. Everything is pointing to that great event. but before Christ appears, God will pour out his spirit in a great measure and He will move in supernatural power as never before.

We read in the Bible of the time when John the Baptist was presented along the Jordon. He said. I can give you the waterworks but there's a greater preacher than I who will give you the power-works. It's more important that you get the fireworks than the waterworks. You can leave the Jordon dripping, but when you leave Jesus, you'll leave him blating with the fire of the Holy Goost He promises to give the Holy Spirit to all that ask Him for it Friends Jesus lives us too much to deceive us. It's midnight and I'm in bed with my children You'll just have to wait." The man outside just kept knocking and crying, "Give me some bread!" The Bible says that because of the continued knocking, the man arose and shoved a loaf of bread through the door . . . saying, "Take it! If you don't go away, I won't get any sleep." The Bible says, "KNOCK AND IT SHALL BE OPENED UNTO YOU! Seek and ye shall find. Ask and ye shall receive. If ye then, being evil know how to give good gifts unto your childrent how much more shall your heavenly Father give good gifts unto them that ask of him?

Recently, a woman attended one of the services in the Dallas Revival Center, who had been blind for 18 years. Her name is Hester Mitchell, Dr. Pollack of Ardmore, Okishoma, had examined her and informed her that she had an incurable affliction. He said. Mrs. Mitchell you'll never see, You will always be blind." That woman came to be prayed for one night in Ardmore, I prayed for her, but she did not receive her sight. The next night, she came again . . . and the third fourth and fifth night, I looked up on the sixth and seventh nights and there she was in the healing lines. I said, "My God that woman's going to keep coming until she gets something." God spoke to me and said. "That's what I want her to do! Seek and ye shall find . knock and it shall be opened unto you!" The tenth night the blind woman came again. I laid my hands upon her and I said, "Lord, if you don't heal her tonight she's going to weary me and You both with her much coming." Suddenly as I prayed for her, God opened those blind eyes. She left the service reading signs, the Bible and other things. She told the people the color of the clothes they were. When she arrived at her home, her children kept her up into the early hours of the morning having her read to them. For 18 years she had walked in darkness, but now she could see . . . because she KEPT ON KNOCKING!


The Bible said that the woman who had come to the unjust judge was only a little widow. . . a very unimportant person. The Bible says also that except a man become as a little child, he can in no wise enter into the kingdom of Heaven. I believe that you must ap-

proach God as a little child to receive anything from Him. I don't believe that one who comes in a healing line with prejudice, hatred or self-righteousness in his heart can ever expect to be healed. You must humble yourself and exercise child-like faith that God will meet your need and it shall be done!

I will never forget an incident in

Winston-Salem, North Carolina, during one of my tent meetings. One night, while praying for the sick, a little girl about eight years old was brought forward. She looked up with faith in her eyes and said, "Brother Coe, tonight God is going to heal me," The father reached down and patted her upon the head and said, "Honey, if it doesn't happen just like you expect it to, don't get discouraged!" She said, "Daddy, I'm not discouraged. I'm asking. Brother Coe said the other night that if we would ask, we would receive and I'm going to get healed." Some of us older people often say, "If, and, but or maybe." You'll never receive if you allow those words to crowd into your mind. You must look up in child-like faith and say, "God I expect!" I prayed for that little child. After I had prayed for her, I said, "Take those braces off." They removed the braces and she began to walk. She walked down the platform, still limping on that withered leg. She turned around and started back toward us. The father said, "She's walking, but that leg isn't like it once was." The little girl said, "Yes, daddy, but it will be!" When she said that, my faith was encouraged and I didn't pray for her again. I said, "Daddy, don't put those braces on again." They were poor people, so I turned to the crowd and said, "Someone give this little girl enough money to buy a pair of shoes." I believe there must have been at least 100 people who stood and offered the money. I selected one man and he gave them enough to purchase the shoes. At 6 o'clock the next morning, the little child awoke the father and said, "Come on, daddy, let's go get my shoes." He said "Honey, the stores are not open yet." She said, "That doesn't make any difference. I want to be there when they open." The daddy arose and they got into the car and were at the store when the proprietor arrived. They asked for the shoes. He fitted the good foot. Then he looked at the withered foot and said. "We'll have to have a smaller shoe for that foot." The father said. "Yes, give us a smaller size for the crippled foot." The little girl said, 'No. daddy, I don't want a smaller



When Jack Coe visited Binghamton, New York, ten days ago, intending only to spend a few pleasant hours with his friend, George Gardner, of the Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship, we did not anticipate what later developed into a short but impressive series of meetings. The revival actually began the day before Brother Coe was to speak in the regular weekday meeting of Faith Tabernacle. Faith was high for what was to have been a single evening with Jack Coe, However, a great altar call and a number of miraculous healings seemed to indicate the will of God for the services to continue.

It was necessary to schedule the meetings in three different auditoriums and there was no time to meet deadlines in the newspapers. Nevertheless, through the ministry of our radio program, The Voice of Pentecost, and

word of mouth advertising set in motion by long distance telephone calls, we experienced the largest congregations which have ever attended our healing meetings. Because of the tremendous crowds and the great number desiring prayer, it was impossible for every one to get into the prayer lines. On the final Sunday Brother Coe was on his feet without rest from 9:30 in the morning until 10:30 in the evening. Sunday night two prayer lines were formed with Brother Coe and Brother Gardner praying for the sick. It was an inspiring sight to see a minister and a layman praying for the sick and the Lord working with both, and confirming the Word with signs following.

Probably the most inspiring service of all for the Faith Tabernacle people was the morning Bible class on the last Sunday of the meeting. We had arranged for Brother Coe to teach. Three hundred and twenty-eight people were present, setting a new record for us, but the high spot came when the Sun-

day School merged into the morning service and then into a building fund drive at which \$15,500 was raised for the new Faith Tabernacle building. The budget for the meetings, some \$1,600, had been raised in the first three meetings.

We found Brother and Sister Coe cooperative in every way and helpful to the point of sacrifice in our own financial drive. We gladly gave two offerings for the orphanage and our Junior WMC is adopting one of the girls.

There is not space to report all the healings but growths of various kinds and goiters disappeared before the eyes of the congregation. One man, bedridden for five years, rose from his am-

shoe. Brother Coe said 'a PAIR of shoes'." They talked and talked to her, but they could not persuade her to accept a smaller shoe. Finally the owner of the store tied the large shoe on her foot. As they started home, the father and mother heard a joyful cry from the back seat of the car. The little child had her hands in the air praising God. The father said, "What is it, honey?" She said, "Oh daddy, look! I told you that it would be so." She raised her foot and it was identical in size to the other foot. God had completed the work! She had asked and she had received.

Recently, we had a man in our opening services at the Dallas Revival Center by the name of George Gardner. He is the president of the American Automobile Association. About a year ago, he came under a tent where I was preaching, with an arm that was twisted, a partially paralyzed body and with a heart affliction. He sat in a chair and told his wife, "We're going to see one of the biggest farces we have ever seen. That man will hypnotize those people." As he sat watching, the deaf heard, the blind saw, the cripples walked and goiters disappeared. He fell upon his knees and repented. God saved him . . . and healed him of every affliction in his body. He told me later, "Brother Coe, I had to become nothing before I could ever find God."

Many times, those who come to the meetings, want to shift the entire responsibility to the preacher. They glorify the evangelist when there are miraculous healings. But I feel like Peter, who cried, "Why look on us as though it was by our holiness that this man was healed." We are nothing. We are only people like yourselves, redeemed by the blood of Jesus. The Bible says; that if two or more shall agree as touching any one thing, it shall be done. All you have to do is to get together with someone and agree that Jesus is going to do whatever you ask Him for. If you and I could agree, everyone in an entire church would be healed.

A man came to me during a meeting in Pampa, Texas and asked me if my car could be moved from a rear entrance so that he might bring his invalid wife in for prayer. She had been paralyzed for 12 years. He told me that he had taken her to the great healing campaigns from Maine to Florida. He said that he had tried every doctor and clinic that he heard about. He said, "My wife insists on going to these meetings and I have brought her here to try to satisfy her. She's driving me crazy," I went out and moved my

car. They brought his wife in and laid her on a couch near the front of the auditorium. When the time came to pray for the sick, I bent over and took her hand. A little woman who was at least 80 years old was sitting on the front seat. She began to cry and pray, "God, I'm an old woman. God heal that woman on that bed. If you want to make me sick, it'll be alright, but she's young. Her life's before her. Heal her Lord!" When I had finished praying for the young woman, she looked up and said, "Thank you, Brother Coe. I'm healed!" I thought, "If you're healed, why don't you get up off that couch?" After the service, her husband carried her out the door to his car. As she went out the door, she turned and said, "Thanks for praying for me. God has healed me." They put her to bed. The next morning they all went down to breakfast, leaving her to sleep. Suddenly she awoke. God spoke to her and said, "I have healed you. You can get out of bed." She said, "Thank you, Lord. I knew it all the time." She slipped her feet into her houseshoes and found a bathrobe. Then she walked into the kitchen for the first time in 12 years. Her husband and children sprang to their feet with cries of amazement. I asked the woman when she attended the meeting shortly afterward,

"Why did you attend so many meetings without receiving your healing?" She said, "I knew that somewhere, someday, God would heal me. He told me in his word to keep KNOCKING!"

Some people have criticized those who who were afflicted for going through countless healing lines for prayer. If I were sick, I would attend every meeting and get into every healing line that was formed. I would LIVE in those meetings until I received my deliverance.

While I was holding a revival in Castro Valley, California, I preached on the radio daily. A man in a critical condition was lying in the hospital with heart trouble and ruptures. Doctors could give him no hope for recovery. He had been listening to my broadcasts. When his wife came to visit him one afternoon, he said, "Honey when you come tonight, bring my clothes. I'm going to a healing meeting." She reached over and patted him on the head and said "Yes, darling." She thought that they must have given him injections to relieve his pain and that he must have been 'doped.' She brought him no clothes when she came. He asked, "Where are the clothes I told you to bring me?" She said, "I had a talk with the doctor and he thinks you had better wait." He said, "I'm not waiting. I'm going to that healing meeting. God's going to heal me!" She left without getting him any clothes. He slipped out of the bed and began to look for something to wear. He could find none, so he took the bed sheet and pinned it around him. That desperate man climbed down the fire escape and walked over to a taxi-stand. He crawled into a taxi and shoved his finger into the driver's back. He said in a stern voice, "Take me to Castro Valley." The taxi driver quickly drove him to my tent, thinking that the man was holding a gun at his back. The man jumped from the taxi and said to one of the ushers, "Give me five dollars to pay this taxi driver with!" The surprised usher reached into his pocket and handed five dollars to the man in the white sheet. He told me later that he thought an angel had come into our tent. He said that he had given the man the money before he even had time to think. The man paid the taxi driver and came walking into the tent. I looked at him and wondered what sect he belonged to. I thought he must be a deluded fanatic who believed that he was one of the apostles. When I started to pray for the sick, the man came

to me and said, "Lay your hands upon me. I want to be healed of heart trouble. I also have nine ruptures across my stomach. The doctors have told me that I cannot live." I laid my hands on his head and the power of God rushed through his body. Around the tent he ran, shouting and yelling, "I'm healed, I'm healed, I'm healed!" Brother, I tell you on the authority of God's word, that on the day you look for God you will find Him. He said, "Seek and ye shall find. Knock and it SHALL be opened unto you."

You may tell me, "I've come once!" I say, "Come again!" He's the ONLY one that can help you when human remedies have failed! If you have been to every doctor and every clinic with no success... there is still one physician who has never lost a case. Jesus will not turn you down. Knock on HIS door. Keep knocking... keep knocking... keep knocking! Contend for what you need. He has promised to answer.
