Confessing Healing

We are told that we should
make God's Word our confession
in regard to our healing. God says,
"By his stripes we were healed."
Since He says that of us we
should confess it. But suppose that
while we confess it there is evi-
dence that contradicts it.

For instance, suppose my voice
is very hoarse with laryngitis. I
say to my friends, "I am healed."
I was given healing when I was
born again. I have Scriptural evi-
dence of my having been healed.
Isaiah 53:4 and 1 Peter 2:24 de-
clare it. God's Word is true. It is
fact."

When a statement like that is
heard by most people, there will
immediately come into their minds
the thought that I have become a
Christian Scientist, or, if I have
not knowingly espoused this cult,
I have adopted one of their tenets
—the non-existence of sin and dis-
ease. Now do I owe them and the
Truth an explanation? They are
honest in their opinion about me.
They need enlightenment on the
subject of healing, especially as to
the method of obtaining it. What
can I say further that will not
repudiate the confession just made,
and at the same time will not per-
mit them to think I have become a
Christian Scientist?

The solution to this question is
to be found in the nature and work
of Satan. His nature and activities
are the explanation to my friends'
questioning suspicions about my
confession.

Speaking of Satan, Jesus said in
John 4:44, "When he speaketh a
lie he speaketh of his own: for he
is a liar, and the father thereof."
Satan is always busy lying about
us. Since we "were" healed by
Jesus' stripes when we were cre-
ated in Christ Jesus, we are now
absolutely and entirely well. But
Satan lies about that healing.

His lies take the form of pain,
weakness and other symptoms
such as an impediment of the
voice, as already mentioned.

When I make confession of my
healing I say, "I was given heal-
ing when I was given Eternal Life
—it is a very part of that life.
That which is now evident to the
senses is merely a lie of Satan."

It is exactly the same as if he
spoke in an audible voice and said,
"Yea, hath God said you were
healed? You were not healed. I
offer as my testimony the pain and
weakness you now experience. I
am telling you the truth. It is God
that is the liar."

When Jonah was in the belly of
the great fish he faced the same
problem we have to face at times
in our "fight of faith." He was
presented with physical denials of
God's Word. He calls them "lying
vanities." Jonah 2:8. He recognized
physical evidences contrary to the
Word of God as the lies that they
are. He gave thanks for his deliv-
erance at the time it was not in
evidence.

As soon as he gave thanks for
what he had but could not see, and
admitted that Jehovah was his
Savior, God stepped in and hon-
ored his confession. He delivered
him. "And Jehovah spake unto the
fish and it vomited out Jonah upon
dry land."

Yes, we are always correct and
truthful when we confess what
God says, no matter how misunder-
stood we may be and no matter
how apparently convincing are the
evidences that contradict it.

God's Word is always true!
"Thy Word is truth." John 17:17.

God's Word is fact. All that
denies it is false. What God says is!

His blessings.

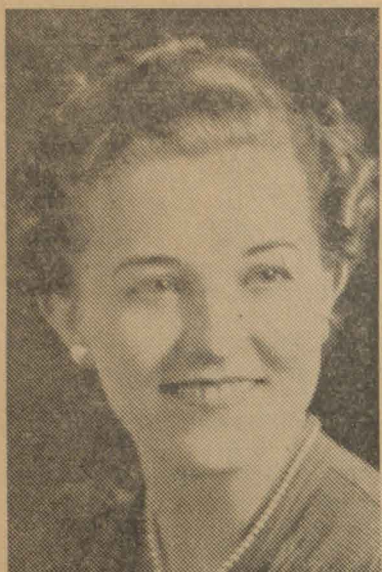
2. Praise blesses the one who

There are three prayer-problems which I would like to bring to your attention: first, the effective prayer for souls; second, the effective prayer for finances; and third, the sincere bearing of another's burden.

Day after day you are meeting a never-ending stream of people.

They are restless, unsettled, searching for something that will satisfy.

You can read it in their eyes, hear it in their voices, feel it in their handclasp. You can see it in the very manner in which they walk.

You hear your neighbors scolding and fretting with the children . . . you notice the worn look on their faces.

All these things are but a manifestation of a deep-seated need . . . a need for the Son of God; a Savior, a Rest, a Peace, a Strength, a very Quietness which they do not have.

In your church services, strangers are constantly coming into your midst. The big percentage of them are unsaved, and they are looking, searching for that something.

Perhaps your own members are attempting to carry on in an outward way a life which they do not possess inwardly.

Then, from across the waters come calls for help from the mission fields.

Prayer is the only channel.

God has shut everything up to prayer.

These heartaches and burdens can only be met through prayer.

The man or woman who gets down into heart-searching prayer is the channel through whom God can work.

The one who takes these burdens and bears them to the Lord in prayer is also the one whom the Lord can trust to go out and speak the necessary word when the time comes.

In other words, the one who prays is a personal worker, and the personal worker is of necessity a prayer warrior.

We are daily confronted with the financial problem.

This may be for the financial needs in the home, in the church, or in the mission field.

God's People, God's work, are limping along, skimping a little here and pinching a little there to make both ends meet, when God's storehouse is full and running over.

There are avenues of endeavor which would mean the carrying of the message to hundreds of thousands of people . . . the door is standing wide open, and yet the Church is too feeble to crawl across the threshold!

Again, the "Why?" is answered in the simple statement that we have failed to pray.

We don't need to ask another to give.

We do not need to make public appeals for extra funds.

Here is the secret.

If I am honestly giving all that my Lord expects me to give, then I can honestly pray that He will pour out of His abundance.

The inward man is conscious of the fact that he cannot hide anything from God. Man may fool man, but there can be no secrets from the Father.

One may rise and address, publicly, a prayer to the God of the Universe, and he may seem very spiritual in the eyes of man, but he knows in his heart whether God hears him or not.

This is not a matter in which man can judge man. It is a matter in which each one, in his own heart, must judge himself.

Then there is the third problem. What do you do when someone asks you to pray for him?

Have you promised to pray for

individuals and then failed to even remember the request?

Have you received their request as a real burden and conveyed that trust to the throne of Grace?

Have you been faithful to those who have trusted you with their hearts' problems?

The hungry hearts of the unsatisfied are looking to you and expecting results when you pray.

The burdened heart of your brother or sister in the Lord expects to feel a lifting of the heart-crushing pressure when you pray.

We must become real blood-covenant men and women and really share each others burdens. Dwell in the Word and become a real prayer warrior.

Join the prayer ranks. Spend much time in the secret of His Presence . . . shut away where only the ear of the Father will hear, and hearing, He will answer. Jer. 33:3.

KNOWING THE FATHER

God's purpose in Redemption was to the end that He might give to man His own nature, Eternal Life.

Eternal Life gives man the place of a son in the Father's Family.

It restores the fellowship that was lost through the entrance of Spiritual Death into the world.

"God is faithful, through whom ye were called into the fellowship of his son Jesus Christ our Lord." 1 Cor. 1:9.

Now that man possesses Eternal Life and enjoys fellowship with the Father and Son, is there a Divine reason for that fellowship? We believe there is.

"And this is life eternal, that they should know thee the only true God, and him whom thou didst send, even Jesus Christ." John 17:3.

The reason for our receiving Eternal Life and becoming God's child is that we might through our fellowship with Him, come to know Him and the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.
