THE CROSS

E. W. Kenyon

The Cross has always appealed to the imagination of men.

The Cross is the revelation of man's failure, and of God's going to the depths of that failure to save man from himself.

On that Cross, Christ tasted the bitterness of Satan's dominion over men . . . the depths of man's defeat. Love was made sin and weakness to save man.

There are eleven references to the Cross in the Epistles. It might be well that you read each one of them.

I Cor. 1:17 "For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not in wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made void."

I Cor. 1:18 "For the word of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us who are saved it is the power of God."

Gal. 5:11 "But I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why am I still persecuted? then hath the stumbling-block of the cross been done away."

Gal. 6:12 "As many as desire to make a fair show in the flesh, they compel you to be circumcised; only that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ."

Gal. 6:14 "But far be it from me to glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world hath been crucified unto me, and I unto the world."

Eph. 2:16 "And might reconcile them both in one body unto God through the cross, having slain the enmity thereby."

Phil. 2:8 "And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, becoming obedient even unto death, yea, the death of the cross."

Phil. 3:18 "For many walk, of whom I told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ."

Col. 1:20 "And through him to reconcile all things unto himself, having made peace through the blood of his cross."

Col. 2:14 "Having blotted out the bond written in ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us: and he hath taken it out of the way, nailing it to the cross."

Heb. 12:2 "Looking unto Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross."

John 19:30, Jesus cried, "It is finished; and he bowed his head, and gave up his spirit."

This has no reference to the sin problem, but to the First Covenant and its law.

Col. 2:14 makes this clear. "Having blotted out the bond written in ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us; and he hath taken it out of the way, nailing it to the cross."

Jesus did not nail our sins to the cross, but on the cross God laid our sins upon Him.

If Jesus had finished our Redemption on the cross before He died, He need not have died.

Or, if His physical death paid the penalty for our sins, then our sins were not spiritual death and union with Satan, but merely the transgression of the law. A New Birth would then be unnecessary.

Gal. 6:12-14 gives us an inkling of what the cross meant spiritually. "The world hath been crucified unto me, and I unto the world."

It cannot mean to us as Gentiles what it meant to Paul, the Jew.

For him to take Christ as Saviour and Lord, meant that he took

over the stigma and shame of the cross.

Gal. 2:20 He cries, "I have been crucified with Christ."

Paul identified himself with the thorn-crowned Man of Calvary.

The Cross was the place of shame, of nakedness, and of an outcast.

The Death on the Cross

The crucifixion of Jesus had in itself no salvation for us. It was but one of the steps that led to His finished work, which was consummated when He carried His blood into the Heavenly Holy of Holies.

Heb. 9:12 "But with his own blood, entered in once for all into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption."

Gal. 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I that live, but Christ liveth in me."

The revelation God gave Paul shows that when Christ died on the Cross, in the mind of justice, we died too; for we were nailed to the cross of Christ.

Rom. 6:10 "For the death that he died, he died unto sin once: but the life that he liveth, he liveth unto God."

That death was not for Himself, but for us. God laid our spiritual death nature upon Him. He partook of our sin.

2 Cor. 5:21 "Him who knew no sin he made to be sin on our behalf; that we might become the righteousness of God in him."

Rom. 6:5 "For if we have become united with him in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection."

He was made sin with our sin, and we became united with Him on the Cross. His death to sin was our death.

When Jesus was justified, we were justified with Him, for we died with Him.

If death has no more dominion over Him, it has no more dominion over you; for you died with Him.

RAISED WITH HIM

When God raised Christ from the dead, He also raised the Church, the Body of Christ.

We were raised with Him. We share in His victory.

"And raised us up with Him, and made us to sit with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus." Eph. 2:6.

His Resurrection meant that the dominion and authority of Satan over the human race was ended.

"For our wrestling is not against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." Eph. 6:12.

These are the forces Christ disarmed and brought to nought.

"Having despoiled the principalities and the powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it." Col. 2:15.

The battle is won. Satan is conquered.

He is eternally defeated, and that victory is ours.

He conquered Satan and in the mind of the Father we are the victors.

"Ye are of God, my little children, and have overcome them . . ." 1 John 4:4.

Christ didn't need to defeat Satan for Himself for He was always stronger than Satan, but He did it for us. We were identified with Him in that combat, so the victory belongs to us.

It is true that Satan is still in the world. He is the God of the world, but he has no authority over the New Creation.

" . . . for the prince of the world cometh! and he hath nothing in me." John 14:30.

He has no authority over Christ and so he has no authority over us.

We are Satan's masters today. Our days of bondage to fear, want, sin and sickness are over.

The Father sees us completely delivered from all the works of darkness through our Identification with Christ.

WE ARE JUSTIFIED

The climax of all that God wrought in Christ was the justification of the man who has faith in Jesus.

Justification is another word for righteousness.

It means the ability to stand in the Father's presence without the sense of guilt, or the inferiority that sin works in man.

Rom. 4:25 "Who was delivered up for our trespasses, and was raised for our justification." (or, because we stand right with God.)

Jesus was raised when He had set us right with God.

In other words, Jesus could not have been raised from the dead until we were made right with God.

I Tim. 3:16 "He who was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit."

Here is the heart secret of our Redemption.

Jesus was justified in Spirit before He arose from the dead, and His justification was our justification.

Had He not been justified in Spirit, He never would have been resurrected.

He died under condemnation. He was made sin on our behalf.

Isiah 53:6 "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and Jehovah hath laid on him the iniquity of us all."

2 Cor. 5:21 "Him who knew no sin he made to be sin on our behalf; that we might become the righteousness of God in him."

Sin was not only reckoned to Him, but He was actually made sin with our sin.

Rom. 6:6-7 shows us the object of Jesus' substitutionary sacrifice. "Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with him, that the body of sin might be done away, that so we should no longer be in bondage to sin; for he that hath died is justified from sin."

So when Jesus was justified, justification awaited every man who would believe in Jesus Christ as his Saviour.

Rom. 3:21-26 covers this ground completely.

I would advise you to read it carefully, noticing that the word "righteous" is the key.

The word "justified" or "justification" means "righteousness."

With Jesus Christ identified.

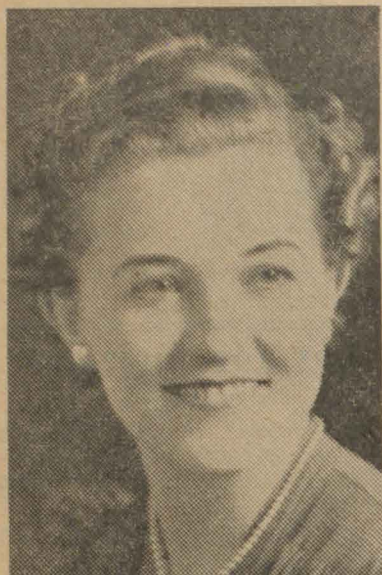
In vict'ry over hell's dark host,

The God of the Unreasonable

People who trust in God and His
Word only, and who, in doing so,
act contrary to the accepted rules
of human wisdom are always mis-
understood by those who are guid-
ed by human wisdom and human
reason. This is just a part of the
perennial conflict between the nat-
ural and the supernatural, be-
tween the flesh and the spirit.

It is no easy matter to rise
above all the influence of heredi-
ty and environment and get up
into the realm of the supernatural,
where we walk by faith and not
by sight. The power of habit and
the force of human reason are tre-
mendously strong. It is strong be-
cause it has behind it all the su-
pernatural power of Satan and his
wicked hosts.

There is one thing that is
stronger. It is the power of faith.
Jesus said that faith would re-
move mountains. It is hard for us
to see this because we are so sur-
rounded by and engulfed in ma-
terialism and every evil force that
fights against faith.

Why is there so little real faith
today? There must be a reason.
It is the presence of Satan and
his evil beings. They have done
and are doing everything possible
to destroy faith. They are afraid
of real faith. "Withal taking up
the shield of faith, wherewith ye
shall be able to quench all the fiery
darts of the evil one." The other
is the sword of the Spirit. "And
take the helmet of salvation and
the sword of the Spirit, which is
the Word of God." Eph. 6:16 and
17.

In order to destroy these two
primary weapons that can prevail
against him, Satan very subtly of-
fers substitutes to earnest well-
meaning people.

These substitutes for the sword
of the Spirit, the Word of God, are
such as the writings of Buddha,
Confucius, The Koran of the Mo-
hammedans, the Talmud of the
Jews, the written traditions and
apocrypha of the Roman Cath-
olics, the Book of Mormon, "Sci-
ence and Health, the Key to the
Scriptures," by Mrs. Eddy, the
writings of Mrs. White and Mrs.
Blavatsky and the metaphysical
cults.

Everyone of these books and
writings offers a human Salvation
and there is no such thing. Man is
by nature and choice a sinner and
cannot lift his finger to save him-
self. Satan has so completely de-
ceived these good, well-meaning
people that they would die for
their beliefs.

We are arrayed against a for-
midable adversary. Let us all take
heed and beware. "For our wrestl-
ing is not against flesh and blood,
but against the principalities,
against the powers, against the
world rulers of this darkness,
against the spiritual hosts of wick-
edness in the heavenly places." Eph. 6:12. Satan has pulled one
of his master strokes in the offer-
ing of these very clever substi-
tutes for the pure Word of God,
the sword of the Spirit. There
is a certain class of people upon
whom he can use that weapon of
false writings.

But there is another class of
people who are further advanced
along the highway of truth and
they refuse to fall for this weapon
of false writings. This second class
of earnest people are Christians.
They have an intelligent faith in
the integrity of God's Word. They
have received such blessings from
the reading and study of it that
they know, not only from its own
claims but also from their own
experience, that it is a book in-
spired by God.

How can Satan capture them?
What weapon of either power or
subtleness can he use effectively
upon them? He can't attack the
weapon, the sword of the Spirit,
for they are fully acquainted with
it and know how to use it. He
makes his attack against the
other weapon, "the shield of faith."

As he offers his substitute for the
Word of God, so he offers his sub-
stitute for faith.

His substitute for faith is even
more clever. It "deceives even the
very elect" as the Scriptures say.
What is this Satan created coun-
terfeit substitute for faith? It is
Mental Assent. Mental Assent is
the full acknowledgement of the
truthfulness of God's Word. It
agrees that the Bible is a Revela-
tion, that it came from God and
that every Word is true, but it
doesn't do anything about that
conviction. It doesn't act upon its
beliefs. Mental Assent does well
until a real test of faith comes.
Then the reasonable and beautiful
theories about the truthfulness of
the Word don't work. Mental As-
sent says, "It is beautiful. I know
I should have it, but for some
reason or other I don't get it. I
cannot understand it. I know it is
God's promise and His revealed
will that no person should perish
and that all should come to a
knowledge of the truth. I prayed
for the Salvation of a loved one,
believing I thought, and yet that
loved one left this life without
receiving Christ as Saviour. I
know, too, that the Word plainly
says that Jesus bore away my
sickness as it does that He bore
away my sins, yet I still feel pain
and still see that swelling. I needed
money to meet an honest obliga-
tion and claimed the promise of
God's Word, but the time came
when the obligation came due and
the money didn't come. What is
the reason for my failure to get by
faith the fulfillment of these plain
promises of God's Word." Every
effect has a cause back of it. Why
didn't your faith work? The rea-
son is this. You didn't have faith.
You had the very clever substitute
of Satan that is Mental Assent.

Mental Assent won't work with
God. He knows the difference. He
is experienced in detecting this old
counterfeit of the devil. Mental
Assent is head belief only. And
one believes so thoroughly, is so
perfectly convinced intellectually
and theoretically that he thinks
that head belief is heart belief. But
it is not.

We can be so completely de-
ceived by Satan's substitute of
Mental Assent for faith that when
some Christian does get a vision
of the real faith, it seems so dif-
ferent and so unreasonable that we
usually cry, "fanaticism, fanaticism.
Don't touch that. Don't lose
your head. Remember, common
sense was given by God. Be rea-
sonable."

Someone will even cite the Scrip-
ture Is. 1:18, "Come now and let
us reason together, said Jehovah."
They will say, "Ours is a reason-
able religion. Therefore we ought
to be reasonable about it." But
that statement, although well
meant, without any doubt is false.

Our religion is not a reasonable
religion. It is above reason. It,
the real thing, reaches into a realm
that we cannot understand, but
that we must admit. That plea,
"Be reasonable" is man's plea. It
is the voice of the natural as op-
posed to the supernatural. It is a
part of the eternal conflict be-
tween Satan and God, between the
flesh and the spirit.

It would say, "Walk by faith in
some things, as long as they seem
reasonable, but don't walk entirely
by faith." God says, "We walk by
faith and not by sight." He doesn't
say, "Walk by faith in some things
as long as they seem to the human
mind to be reasonable, and walk
by sight in other things if they
seem to you unreasonable." The
victory belongs to the one who
walks only by faith, and not by
sight.

Isaiah 1:18 should be quoted in
its entirety. It says, "Come now
and let us reason together, saith
Jehovah, though your sins be as
scarlet they shall be as white as
snow. Though they be red like
crimson, they shall be as wool." That is a plea for the supernatural.

MADE ALIVE IN CHRIST

Eph. 2:5 "Even when we were
dead through our trespasses, made
us alive together with Christ."

In the mind of the Father we
were not only justified when He
justified Christ, but when He made
Christ "alive" before He was
raised from the dead, we were
made "alive together with Him."

I Peter 3:18 "Because Christ
also suffered for sins once, the
righteous for the unrighteous, that
he might bring us to God; being
put to death in the flesh, but made
alive in the spirit."

Jesus had died in Spirit, He was
justified in Spirit, and now He is
made alive in Spirit.

When He was made alive, we
were made alive in Him.

This is one of the most vital
points in our Redemption. Here
is the blessed fact of our Identifi-
cation with Him.

We were one with Him from the
Cross to the Throne Room. We
were crucified with Him, we died
with Him, were buried with Him,
made alive with Him, justified
with Him, we conquered Satan
with Him, arose with Him, and
are now seated together with Him
at the right hand of God.

John 5:24 "He that heareth my
word, and believeth him that sent
me, hath eternal life, and cometh
not into judgment, but hath passed
out of death into life."

Rom. 5:17. "For if by the tres-
pass of the one, death reigned as
a king through the one; much more
shall they that receive the abun-
dance of grace and of the gift of
righteousness reign as kings in the
realm of life." (Weymouth.)

This is a wonderful translation
of a wonderful scripture.

Because you have received eternal
Life, have been made a New
Creation, now you reign in life as
a king.

It is a plea for us to be unreason-
able enough to believe in laws
above those of the five senses and
contrary to reason. This verse tells
of a miracle. You know it took
place in your life. The instant you
believed, your red, vile sins be-
came as white as snow, as wool.
That is contrary to reason. Such a
thing as red being instantly
changed to white just doesn't hap-
pen in the natural realm.

In the New Testament we are
told specifically what to do with
the reasonings that come from na-
tural life, from man's wisdom. 2
Cor. 10:3-5. "For though we walk
in the flesh, we do not war ac-
cording to the flesh, for the wea-
pons of our warfare are not of the
flesh, but mighty before God, to
the casting down of strongholds;
casting down imagination, and
every high thing that is exalted
against the knowledge of God, and
bringing every thought into cap-
tivity to the obedience of Christ."

Man's reasonings come only
from what he has learned through
his five senses. What is he to do
with reasonings? He is to cast
them down. He is to reject them.
He is to have nothing whatever to
do with them. They say, "Believe
the Word only as far as it seems
reasonable and then abandon it
and follow your common sense."

God is the God of the unreason-
able. He is the God of the impos-
sible. He specializes in that which
is impossible to human ability and
to common sense. Our God is
Super-natural! He is above rea-
son. And now He stands ready
to honor those who reject Mental
Assent and man's reason and hold
to real faith, to genuine belief.

Got any rivers that are uncross-
able?

Got any mountains you can't tun-
nel through?

God specializes in things thought
impossible;

He can do what no other power
can do.

"If ye then, being evil, know
how to give good gifts unto your
children, how much more shall
your heavenly Father give the
Holy Spirit to them that ask him." Lu. 11:13.

**JESUS, AT THE RIGHT
HAND OF GOD**

The climax of Redemption is expressed in three words: "He sat down."

He had consummated the work the Father had sent Him to do. He had died as the "Lamb." He had risen as the "Lord High Priest," as the "Lord Mediator," as the "Lord Intercessor," as the "Lord Advocate," and as the "Surety" of the New Covenant.

There are three views of Jesus' ministry:

First . . . Jesus beyond the Cross as the lowly "man of Sorrows," the Son made flesh.

Second . . . Jesus on the cross, the "Son made sin."

Third . . . Jesus seated on the right hand of the Majesty on High, the Son made righteous.

Most teachers and song writers see Jesus only beyond the Cross. Another group can only see Him as a Substitute on the Cross. A small group look beyond the Cross and the Tomb to Christ seated at God's right hand.

He is no longer the meek and lowly Jesus, nor is He the "Son made sin," on our behalf. He has put sin away; He has conquered death, sin, Satan and the grave. He has met humanity's needs, and "sat down" at the right hand of God.

He is no longer the Lamb. He is now the Lord High Priest who is to satisfy the claims of Justice and make the New Birth and righteousness available to lost man.

If God accepts the blood that He offers, Redemption has been completed; the claims of Justice have been met; God is satisfied and can legally restore man, by faith in Jesus, to perfect fellowship with Himself.

Rom. 8:2 "A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, not man."

Jesus' High Priestly Ministry did not end with carrying His blood into the Holy Place. He is still the Minister of the sanctuary, and He ever lives to present our prayers and worship before the Father.

Look up His High Priestly Ministry in the Book of Hebrews. This is the only Epistle that mentions Jesus' High Priestly work.

Look up these references . . . all in Hebrews: 2:17, 3:1, 4:14-16, 5:1-10, 6:20, 7:26-28, 8:1-7, 9:11-14, 10:21.

Too little attention has been paid to Jesus' High Priestly Ministry. The Book of Hebrews represents the present ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ on the behalf of the church.
