"Give ye Them To Eat"

If He commands us to do anything, He is our ability to accomplish the work.

This story of the feeding of the five thousand unfolds to us the mind of the Master toward our part in reaching a disorganized and broken-hearted world.

When He said to them, "Feed ye them," He knew that He had the ability to make five loaves feed five thousand.

I am convinced that He expects us to follow in His footsteps, do the kind of work of which He gave us samples in His earth walk.

I saw so vividly John 1:16 "Of His fulness have we all received, and grace upon grace." We have received His ability, His wisdom, His love nature, and there is absolutely no limit to what we can do with this indwelling ability that has been given to us.

His fulness means His grace, wisdom, and ability to accomplish the Father's will in us and through us.

2 Cor. 3:3-5: He is our sufficiency. No matter what the task may be, no matter how difficult, His ability is at our disposal. He is your sufficiency, the strength, unseen but ready, the wisdom, unappreciated perhaps, but at our disposal at every crisis period.

He would never have said, "Feed ye them" unless He was to be our ability to meet that obligation.

When Peter said, "If it be thou, bid me come unto thee," Jesus answered "Come." He expected Peter to walk the waves. It was a challenge to live in the supernatural. It was an invitation to come out of the failure and weakness of Sense Knowledge into the realm of the spirit.

What He invited Peter to do, He has invited us to do. You who are reading this article now—He invites you to walk the waves with Him.

He invites you to feed the multitudes. Nay, He commands you "Feed ye them."

You dare to feed the spirits of men as He fed their bodies. You have His Word. You have the message. You have the Name of Jesus. You have the same Holy Spirit that indwelt Jesus. You have everything that is necessary to make life big and rich.

You can rescue men out of weakness and failure. You can say, "Come, walk the waves with me."

Read carefully 2 Cor. 9:8 "And God is able to make all grace abound unto you." Here is the fullness thrust upon us. He whispers softly, "That ye, having always all sufficiency in everything, may abound unto every good work."

Paul was original in this respect, that he let God loose in him.

He took advantage of the fact that, "Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world."

When Paul gave up the Religion of the First Covenant, he had none.

He was simply a New Creation in Christ.

He was a God indwelt man.

When he said, "For it is God who is at work within, both willing and working His own good pleasure," he was speaking of his own experience.

Way's translation of II. Cor. 10: 3-6 is a striking illustration of this truth, "Very human as I am, I do not fight with merely human weapons of mere flesh and blood, but, in the strength of God, they are mighty enough to raze all strongholds of our foes. Paul knew that he was born of God.

He knew that he had the Father's nature.

He knew that he had the mighty Spirit, who raised up Jesus from the dead dwelling in him.

In this great scripture we see the reality of Indwelling.

God in Paul doing things!

Paul lived in every adverse condition imaginable.

He was in prison among vile company and unsanitary conditions, yet never defeated, he was a victor in Christ.

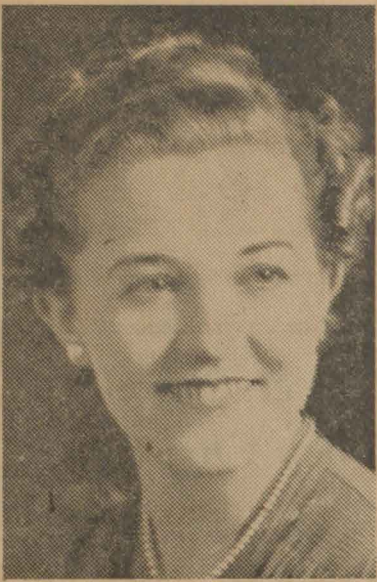

How To Get Faith

I am going to say something
now that every Christian can and
should say. "I have my healing.
It was made possible over 1900
years ago and was given to me
when I received Eternal Life.
Healing has nothing to do with
physical evidence or feelings.
These are often Satan's lies. It is
only facts that matter, and the
fact is that I have perfect health.
I do not struggle to believe to re-
ceive my healing. I merely rest.
I praise God for the healing He
has already worked out for me
and given to me."

The foregoing is what every
Christian should say. We should
never pray for our healing, but
praise God for it. If one prays for
it he thereby confesses he doesn't
have it and that he has only hope
that he will get it. Hope never will
bring the blessing of healing, or
any other blessing.

There is clear-cut distinction be-
tween hope and faith. Much of our
spiritual misunderstanding comes
from confusing their identity. In
reality, the two are mutually ex-
clusive. That means they have
nothing in common. Hope and faith
are enemies. Hope is your enemy
if you are not healed. Learn to
hate it. Hope is often a usurper.
In so many Christians' lives it is
taking the place that faith should
occupy.

Faith is merely recognizing the
fact that God is loving and power-
ful and did prove His love for us
by His Substitutionary Sacrifice
for our whole being. Instead of
faith being the hardest thing in
the world to "get," as the strug-
gling Christian thinks, it is the
easiest thing to get because it
depends upon God's faithfulness
and God stands in His faithfulness
whether or not we have faith.
Rom. 3:3, "For what if some were
without faith? Shall their want of
faith make of none effect the
faithfulness of God?" and 2 Tim.
2:13, "If we are faithless, He
abideth faithful, for He cannot
deny Himself." Faith is our merely
facing the fact and admitting that
God is loving and Christ is our
Redemption. That settles it. Forget
about faith. Just rest on the faith-
fulness of God and you'll be having
faith and it is so much better to
have faith than it is to struggle
to try to obtain it.

Struggling and striving have
nothing to do with obtaining faith.
In fact, they repel faith. Faith has
no fight in it. It rests. And resting
is a cessation of fighting. It is
true that 1 Tim. 6:12 says, "Fight
the good fight of faith," but we
understand that when we recog-
nize the nature of faith. Faith
says, "It is done." I received it
when I received Christ. I was then
made a New Creation in Christ
Jesus, and old things became new, and all
these things were of God.

Believe God

Among the many blessings that
were actually given to me then
was that of perfect health. My
physical health is as perfect as my
newly created spirit is perfect. I
say "is now perfect" advisedly for
the present tense is the proper
tense. All evidence to the contrary,
such as pain and physical weak-
ness and the swelling which can
be seen with the eyes are the lies
of Satan. God says, "By His stripes
ye were healed." Satan says that
we were not healed and offers in
evidence pain, soreness and swell-
ing. We must take our choice as
to which to believe. God's very na-
ture is Truth. Jesus said, "I am
the Truth." Satan's nature is the
opposite. He is a "liar and the
father of lying." The sick person
has his choice to make. He must
either believe God or believe Satan.
The issue is clear-cut. There is no
denying or evading it. No com-
promise can be made.

God says we are now healed.
Satan wants us to believe we are
not healed. God offers in evidence
His own character. He swears by
Himself as there is nothing higher

or better to swear by. Satan offers
his evidence which is corruption of
physical flesh and the attendant
pain and debility. Now which is
true? Are you going to believe a
fiendish, diabolical being, who is
your enemy and who is trying to
injure and destroy you, or are you
going to believe Him Who never
uttered a lie and Who could not do
so for it is utterly contrary to His
nature?

But you say, "It hurts right now.
I can see it. I can feel it. Do you
mean to say I should deny what I
see and feel? Yes, that is exactly
what we are to deny—since God
says the very opposite. We are to
say, "Yes, let God be found true,
but every man a liar."

In his effort to "get" faith, the
average earnest Christian thinks
he can "get" a little faith from
reading this or reading that or
from hearing of this experience or
that experience of healing. From
these sources he thinks he can
accumulate sufficient faith to ap-
pear before God and say to Him,
"Now see here, I've finally, after
a great deal of hard work, received
enough faith. Here it is. This is,
or ought to be, enough to heal me.
I give it to you now. I've earned
my healing. Please give it to me
in exchange for this large amount
of faith I've finally got to myself."

Faith Is Unconscious of Itself

That is not the way to get heal-
ing or any other blessing. That
idea is wrong because it contains
the element of struggle, which is
self-effort or works, and of this
important fact about faith: Faith
is always unconscious of itself.

When Peter got down out of that
boat and walked on the water to
come to Jesus he was utterly un-
conscious of his exerting faith.
The only thing in his mind at that
time was Jesus, at Whom he was
looking, and His command to
come. He knew that a command
is always an enabling. It was when
the consciousness of what he was
doing crept into his mind, through
his looking away from Jesus and
at the waves, that he became con-
scious of himself and his exploit
of faith. Faith sees only God and
His Promise.

It seems strange, doesn't it, that
we should be told so much about
faith in the Bible and then after
having been told so much about it
and its possibilities, we should be
told to forget it. But that is so.
The phrase, "forget your faith," is
not in the Bible, but the illustrated
fact is certainly there.

An example of "forgetting faith"
may be given from my own experi-
ence. When I was a student in
Occidental College I attended a
Victorious Life Conference one
summer held at Whittier College.
I had been reading and studying
about the Victorious life and I
wanted it! It was an overpowering
desire in my life. I went to the
Conference with the hope and deter-
mination to "get" it. I went
through five and a half days seek-
ing it. I was tense every moment
of the time. I listened eagerly to
every speaker and took notes to
study later. I sought personal con-
ferences and all did their best for
me. I talked to friends who already
had this Victorious Life. They were
unable to help me. I became
worried for the Conference was
drawing to a close. I sought a last
interview with another speaker.
We sat down on the grass in front
of one of the college buildings. I
remember one thing he said.
"God's Word is just as sure and
dependable as this ground upon
which we are sitting." It was that
simple remark about the depend-
ability of His Word. I rested. I
gave up all struggle to believe.

How well I remember the hour
that followed. I had been looking
for feelings. I wanted evidence of
the senses before believing. I
hadn't realized that God's Word is
all the evidence we need. I was
now living in the realm of Revela-
tion Knowledge and I found it was
so superior to the Sense Knowl-
edge realm. I found that God is

It is difficult to write of spirit-

want rest and quietness for our

the spirit cry.

We are three-fold beings. We
have a body, a soul, and a spirit.
We live in our bodies. Our soul
or mind, which includes the will,
is ours to use, but the spirit is the
real you, and only through the
spirit can you find and know God.

We have seen ourselves as two-
fold. We have been conscious of
our bodies and souls and have
worked hard to furnish food for
both, but we have been uncon-
scious of our spirits and we have
had no concern not knowing our
spirits needed food and were re-
ally hungry for God. We can
satisfy our bodies with food and
our souls with music and the arts,
but only God will satisfy the hun-
ger in the spirit of man, and man
is hungry for God, whether he
realizes it or not.

Why is man in this condition
with a mind that is enmity against
God?

We will have to go back to our
first parents, Adam and Eve, to
answer that question.

Adam was the federal head of
the human race and in the eyes
of God we were identified with
him in all he did. He was created
in such a way that it was possible
for his spirit to be filled with
God's Life, which is Eternal Life,
the nature of God, but he partook
of the nature of Satan, Spiritual
Death.

Word but he will likely not want
it, for he is happy in knowing he
has "the real thing" in having the

GIVING IS THE BASIS OF RECEIVING

I could give you many illustra-
tions of people who have been
praying for healing and failed to
get it until they began tithing.

There would be more giving if
we understood the blessings that
come from giving.

Money is the smallest part of
real giving . . . the giving of a
friendly word, the taking time to
shake hands and smile.

Give your prayers!

Oh, what it would mean if we
freely gave our prayer life, gave
of our prayer time!

We would tell people about it.
We would say gently, "I am pray-
ing for you. I was waiting before

Spiritism Unveiled

(Cont. from last month)

I have spoken to this Medium's guide just as I might speak to you.

All who attended these Seances heard the voice too but none saw the one speaking. One time the Medium and I were in a room alone, the room was well lighted, and while she sat on a chair and under Hypnosis her guide spoke to me, the voice coming from under the chair on which the Medium sat. At times the language of the guide betrayed him, he would use the Name of the Lord in vain, this caused me to think that he was not of the Lord, which I now know was correct.

This guide also told me that the only light he got was when he came to these seances, so I asked him how he got into the darkness? and he said, "I killed two men and then I killed myself, don't you ever do what I did or you too will be in darkness." "Wow!" This took me off my feet for I fell for it like a hungry fish for bait. So blinded was I that I thought that was good gospel, but so did Eve when Satan told her she would not surely die. My eyes began to gradually open and I began to see.

I was playing with the Devil and didn't know it, up to now I was surely taken in. Lev. 20: 27, "A man also or a woman that hath a familiar spirit, or that is a wizard, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones; their blood shall be upon them."

The foregone scriptures are sufficient to prove our point, that is, that Spiritism is of the Devil and wholly condemned of God.

If you care to look up further references we will now give them: Deut. 18:10-12, I Sam. 28:3, I Sam. 28:7-9, 2 Kings 21:6, 2 Kings 23:24, Isa. 8:19, "And when they shall say unto you, seek them that have

FAMILIAR SPIRITS and unto wizards, that CHIRP AND THAT MUTTER: SHOULD NOT A PEOPLE SEEK UNTO THEIR GOD? on behalf of the living should they seek unto the dead?" This scripture leaves no doubt as to who or what produces Spiritistic phenomena.

New Testament Examples of Mediumship or Witchcraft

Act. 13:6-12. Here we find one Elymas a sorcerer who attempted to hinder The Apostle Paul in the spread of the gospel, Paul fastens his eyes upon him and speaks in no uncertain terms, "O full of guile and all villainy, thou son of the Devil, thou enemy of righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?" And then Elymas became blind, blind two ways, he was already blind spiritually and now physically, no doubt until he stopped perverting the right way of God.

Act. 8:9-24, Here we find one Simon a former sorcerer who believed and was baptized and yet when he saw the great miracles performed by the apostles he offered them money thinking he could buy the power exercised by the Apostles. Peter told him he had neither part nor lot in that matter and that his heart was not right before God, he was to repent and pray the Lord that PERHAPS the thought of his heart might be forgiven him. We see that fellowship with the Lord cannot be maintained when our thoughts are evil.

In Act 16:16, We see two preachers cast into prison over a Spiritistic Medium. This scripture is too long to quote, but if you will read the entire chapter of Act 16, you will get the story. Paul and Silas are the preachers. The Medium is mentioned in the 16th verse.

I John 4:1-6, Here we are admonished to try the spirits to see whether they are of God.

I Tim. 4:1, But the Spirit sayeth expressly, that in later times some shall fall away from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of demons. This is just what Spiritism is doing to-day.

One cannot serve the table of God and of Demons, there must be a choice made for one or the other.
