Acting on the Word

There are two parts to faith. Some Christians are naturally inclined to emphasize one part, and some, the other part. Each part of faith should be kept in its place, and neither part overlooked.

To superficial students of the Word there seems to be a conflict in the teaching of the book of Romans and the book of James on this subject. We read in Romans 4:5, "But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is reckoned for righteousness." It says, "to him that worketh not," and in James we read, in James 2:17, "Even so faith, if it have not works, is dead in itself." And in James 2:24, "Ye see that by works a man is justified, and not only by faith." How can we explain this seeming contradiction?

Faith is the giving of one's self utterly over to a fact. Faith is complete, unfeigned trust in a principle or statement or person. Faith is an utter abandoning of one's self to a truth.

Now I am going to express a principle that will explain this seeming contradiction between faith and works. It is very simple, and you will immediately recognize it as being true. Here it is: When you really believe anything you will do something about it. You will act upon it. No actions, no faith, is the unvarying law of faith. That is just what inspired James when he said in James 2:17, "Even so faith, if it have not works, is dead in itself," and in James 2:24, "Ye see that by works a man is justified, and not only by
