The Deliverance of Paul Cain

Twice Paul Cain has been doomed to die and twice he has been delivered by the hand of God!

The first sentence of death was in operation before Paul's birth, because his mother, then 45, was doomed to die of tuberculosis and cancer. Tuberculosis had almost consumed both her lungs, and cancer had almost destroyed both her breasts. The cancer in one breast had eaten through to one of the tubercular lungs. Three large, cancerous tumors infested her womb, making death for herself and the baby certain.

Some of the finest specialists in the country in the fields of tuberculosis and cancer had given her up as hopeless and sent her home to die. They declared that if she lived until the time for the baby to be born, sure and swift death would come for the two at that crucial time.

In desperation she called on God for help. Then, as the critical hour approached, the Angel of The Lord came and stood by her bedside. He said to her: "Be of good cheer; you are going to live. The fruit of your womb will be a male child, and you will call his name 'Paul', for he will live to preach the Gospel as did the Apostle Paul of the Bible!"

Finally, the crisis came—the hour when she must go down into the valley of the shadow of death. Then Jesus came and ministered unto her. The same voice that once commanded

the winds and the waves to cease their turbulence whispered assurance to the one now in the shadow land of travail. The nail-scarred hands that once touched the deaf, the blind and the lepers, causing them to hear, to see, and to be made clean, touched her at death's very door!

The tubercular lungs were healed, the cancerous breasts were made whole, the three cancerous tumors of the womb disappeared, and a male child came forth in perfect health, delivered by the very hands of The Great Physician, Jesus Christ!

Amazed medical specialists thoroughly examined the mother and found her to be in perfect physical condition! Even the cancerous breasts, one of which had been so devoured that the cancer had eaten through to one of the tubercular lungs, were so miraculously restored that the mother nursed her baby as Nature intended!

The mother named the baby "Paul", for the Angel of The Lord had said he would preach the Gospel as did the Apostle Paul of the Bible.

This was the first deliverance of Paul Cain by the hand of God!

Twenty-six years elapsed. Mrs. Cain was now 71. The tuberculosis and cancers had never returned. She constantly travelled about the country with her busy evangelist son.

Paul Cain had become the preacher the Angel of The Lord had promised. He had supernatural gifts to such an

extent that he could tell people what diseases afflicted them. He could tell them their church memberships and whether they had the Baptism of the Holy Ghost. He could tell them their names and their addresses and even the very secrets of their hearts!

Under his ministry, congregations beheld cancers fall off faces, broken legs instantly healed, and hearing and sight immediately restored. Hundreds in a single campaign would receive the Baptism of the Holy Ghost and many hundreds would accept Christ as their Saviour.

Suddenly, in the midst of this, the death sentence once more doomed Paul Cain. His liver became inflamed, his heart became weakened, his digestion failed, he lost strength and 45 pounds of weight, and his thinking was hindered. Medical help and prayer had utterly failed! Paul felt he was going to die!

For two long, agonizing months he drew nearer and nearer to death. In one final desperate plea, he phoned William Branham, at Jeffersonville, Indiana, to see if he could use his supernatural gift of healing in an

emergency. But William Branham's gift operates by instructions from the Angel of The Lord, not by his will nor by people's requests, so he could not offer much encouragement to Paul.

Then, in his despairing and dying condition, he felt led of the Lord to go, with his mother, from his home at Garland, Texas, to Hollywood, California. There, the Angel of The Lord appeared to him and said: "A third day will come!" Paul felt this meant that on the third day he would die!

At this same time, FGBMFI Vice-President Miner Arganbright, of La Crescenta, California, phoned William Branham, in Indiana, and learned that Paul Cain's condition, without God's intercession, was hopeless. He then phoned me at my home in South San Gabriel, California, and told me the dismal news.

As I returned to my breakfast table, although I was not personally acquainted with Paul Cain, a great compassion swept over me. I cried out to God: "Father, why don't you raise up someone to get a burden for his deliverance or Satan will destroy him and stop his ministry!"

Calmly and assuringly the Lord replied: "You pray for him and I will heal him — and also heal your voice!"

This answer startled me, for I did not have the faith to assume this stupendous task which others had not accomplished. To strengthen my faith, I said: "Alright, Lord, if you want me to pray for him, have him phone me; and, if possible, have him come to me to be prayed for!" Paul Cain had never phoned me and I did not know how far away he might be or whether he might be on his death-bed in a hospital somewhere, so I considered these requests only God could answer!

The next morning I was at Foundation Press, in Santa Ana, California, where Full Gospel Men's Voice is published, and Dewey Lockman, the manager, said: "Paul Cain phoned you and wants to talk to you." I replied: "Before I talk to him, I want to tell you why he phoned!" Then I related what the Lord had told me the previous morning and my request that the Lord have Paul Cain phone me.

In talking to Paul, I learned that he had come out to Hollywood and was spending most of his time in bed. He had phoned FGBMFI President Demos Shakarian, at Downey, California, for some information, but he had told him: "You phone Tommie Nickel—he'll give you the information you need!" A long-distance call had come from Lee Vayle, Pastor of the First Baptist Church, of Spencerville, Ohio. He told Paul that William Branham had been visited by the Angel of The Lord and was going to have a greater ministry than ever before. He said: "You phone Tommie Nickel—he'll give you the details!"

I was so excited I repeatedly offered to come from Santa Ana to Hollywood to pray for Paul so he could remain in bed and conserve the little remaining strength he had. But repeatedly Paul insisted that he come to my home in South San Gabriel, California, to be prayed for; so four o'clock the next day was set for our meeting there.

Suddenly, the Lord reminded me: "You asked Me to have him phone you and he did. You also asked Me, if possible, to have him come to you to be prayed for, and that is what he is going to do!"

That day and the following day, I endeavored to fast, feeling that fasting would give me added power, but the

Lord reminded me that the transaction was unconditional, that neither Paul nor I were to do anything except what the agreement was: "You pray for him and I will heal him!"

The following afternoon, Paul drove from Hollywood and I drove from Santa Ana and we met at my home in South San Gabriel at four o'clock. We entered the house together, and I felt directed of the Lord to lead Paul to the kitchen and seat him at the very table where the Lord had given His promise.

Then I felt led to go into the living room and get a large German Bible; hand printed and bound in Germany in 1861, containing Martin Luther's commentaries, one of which was: "The just shall live by faith!" I placed the Bible on the table in front of Paul and opened it.

Before praying, I felt led to go close the front door and also to close the kitchen door. I was reminded of the Commandment of Christ: "But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which seeth in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly."

On the table was a note from Hugh Claypool, who, with his mother, live with me, but both of whom were away for the day. The note said: "Paul Cain phoned you."

As I seated myself at the table, I told Paul that I had always been a great believer in God's Commandment, "At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness shall he not be put to death," and in Christ's Commandment, "But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that

in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established."

I pointed out to Paul that God had honored my life-long observance of these Commandments of Himself and His Son. He had caused Demos Shakaran and Lee Vayle both to tell Paul to phone me. He had caused Paul to phone me twice—once at Santa Ana and once at my home. The former was told me by Dewey Lockman and the latter was even put in writing by Hugh Claypool, and the note was right on the very table where God had made His promise and where Paul Cain was sitting. Two men, William Branham and Miner Arganbright, had expressed themselves to feel that without the intercession of God, Paul Cain's condition was hopeless. And, now, two doors had been closed, and I was ready to pray!

Taking one of Paul's hands in one of my hands, I rested them on the open Bible. I placed my other hand on Paul's head and told God that Paul and I had complied with all the conditions of the agreement, that I knew He would keep His part of the agreement, and that heaven and earth would pass away but that His Word would not pass away!

I confessed to God that there was no merit in myself nor Paul but that there was merit in Jesus Christ, our Lord, Saviour and Healer, that we came in His name, and that He is the same yesterday, today and forever!

I thanked the Lord for His goodness and greatness and told Paul he would know he was healed in three days. Then Paul said to me: "Three days ago the Angel of The Lord told me, 'A third day will come!' I thought I would die on the third day, but this is the third day, and instead of my

dying you have prayed for me to be healed!"

I felt led to go look at the German Bible to see on what part of God's Word Paul's hand and mine had rested. I had to get my English Bible for the translation. These two Scriptures from the second and fifth verses of the first chapter of Isaiah leaped out at me as I read them to Paul: "Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: for the Lord hath spoken" and "Why should ye be stricken any more?"

Paul began to eat foods that previ-

ously had caused him unbearable distress, he drove his car all day, and he climbed a 1,500-foot mountain. Then he attended the Los Angeles Chapter of FGBMFI and gave the testimony of his healing over the radio broadcast. That was the third day since I had prayed for him and told him he would know he was healed in three days! Once again, the third day had come, as was promised by the Angel of The Lord!

This was the second deliverance of Paul Cain by the hand of God!

The Gardner-Smith Meeting in Cuba

For over a year, after hearing how God was using FGBMFI Vice-President George Gardner, I and my people prayed that he would come to Cuba for a meeting. Then a letter came from him that he had been praying about coming to Cuba and knew it was the will of the Lord that he come.

Then I arranged for the Municipal Stadium and we began to pray for the meeting. A letter came from Rev. R. D. E. Smith, Pastor of Faith Tabernacle, Binghamton, New York, that he would accompany Brother Gardner. We praised God because we had been praying for Him to send one of His servants and He was sending two.

I borrowed a 16-year-old Chevrolet from a Brother and met them as they arrived on the National Airline, driving them to a hotel in the heart of Havana, about twenty miles from the airport.

A wonderful meeting was held at our Parraga Church, one of more than 30 of our churches and mission stations. Brother Gardner gave a brief message and prayed for individuals for various needs. Two of my own daughters and many others were brought to a closer walk with God. Brother Smith brought a wonderful message on faith. Then both men prayed for the sick, and many were healed. Brother Gardner called out a blind woman. She had never attended church before. He prayed for her and the woman could not see. He prayed for

her again and the woman exclaimed, "I can see!" My own married daughter, Ruth, was healed before she was prayed for. The meeting lasted until midnight.

The following night the meeting was held at my own Lawton Church. Brother Smith brought a wonderful message and many came forward for Salvation. Brother Gardner began praying for the sick. He was power-

fully anointed and God performed miracles.

The next night the meeting was held in our Guines Church, 35 miles out. Here many were saved and many were healed.

The next morning, Sunday, Brothers Gardner and Smith took part in the radio broadcast. That afternoon, a glorious service was held at the Lawton Church.

Sunday night the campaign began in the Municipal Stadium and continued nightly, with afternoon services being held in my own church. In all the services, God honored His Word with signs following. More than 80 sinners were saved, the sick were healed, and the Christians were edified. Three believers were gloriously filled with the Holy Spirit as in Acts 2:4.

A blind woman for whom Brother

Gardner prayed, after having been totally blind for many years, began to shout with joy. I held up a handkerchief and asked her what I had in my hand. "A handkerchief!" she cried. She also counted the number of fingers I held before her.

Brother Gardner pointed out persons with nose, foot and other afflictions, prayed for them, and they were healed. Cases of asthma, hernia, arthritis and kidney trouble were healed, as was my assistant pastor's eight-year-old son who received instantaneous healing from a terribly painful leg affliction.

Now that the meetings are over, the blessings continue and the crowds still come. Many testimonies of salvation and healing are given and a baptismal service has been held. The Gardner-Smith meeting in Cuba brought abundant blessings from God!

Ford and Lock in Seattle and Tacoma Meetings

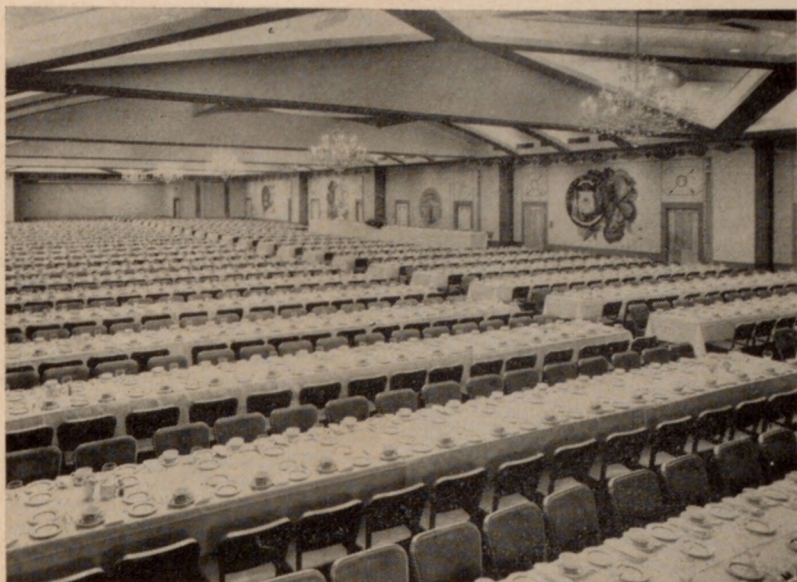

Organized Atheism Attacks Christianity!

Some weeks ago a number of evangelists who pray for the sick and physically disabled at their revival meetings were surprised by getting long distance telephone calls at about two o'clock in the morning from evangelist Jack Coe who was at the time holding a revival campaign in Miami, Florida. According to Rev. Gordon Lindsay who received a call Rev. Coe said, quote, "I have been arrested on charges of practicing medicine without a license, because I prayed for the sick and physically disabled. Before they released me from jail I was forced to raise and post a \$5,000 bond. If they can make this charge stick, they can sentence me up to five years in prison."

In the article written by Gordon Lindsay, editor of the "Voice of Healing" magazine, he said Rev. Coe's attorney, George Chertkof of Miami, explained the seriousness of the situation. According to him evil and determined forces were rallying every weapon at their disposal to secure a conviction and if they were successful every revivalist who prays for the sick and physically handicapped would be in danger of arrest and the future of the healing ministry in general would be in question. In telling about what he called the persecution of the evangelist he called attention to the fact that the case was attracting nationwide attention and that newspapers in distant cities were headlining the story on the front page. To quote

from his article he stated, "moreover one of the strangest alliances in religious history has formed the opposition. First and foremost in promoting and fomenting the persecution was Joseph Lewis, leader and champion of the Freethinkers of America, one of the most deadly and sinister organizations in our country. Mr. Lewis himself is a blatant agnostic who publicly defies God and insults all religion. Allied in this organization were certain groups whose opposition to Divine healing has long been notorious. And third was the newspaper, the Miami Herald, which joined hands in this strange alliance of infidel and professed Christian." This newspaper printed a series of articles claiming the healings were fakes and that the evangelist was a religious racketeer. Rev. Coe is said to have answered the attack by producing hundreds of written testimonies of miracles of healing.

A woman who had brought her child to the meeting to be prayed for, without any apparent result, signed a warrant charging Rev. Jack Coe with practicing medicine without first securing a license. According to the published testimony of the woman in court she was visited by Joseph Lewis who promised her free medical help for her child if she signed a warrant against Rev. Coe. In a published account of the trial the woman was said to have admitted on cross-examination that she had no idea that

when she signed the charges that she might send the preacher to jail.

The item about her testimony also stated she had no idea what the charges were. It was also stated in the article that Joseph Lewis failed to show up during the trial.

The final outcome of the case hinged around whether Rev. Coe in praying for the sick was "engaged in the practice of the religious tenets of the church." Judge Duvall threw the case out of court on the grounds that Jack Coe had only been praying for the sick according to the tenets of his church and faith. Life Magazine published an article about

the court hearing and the vindication of the evangelist.

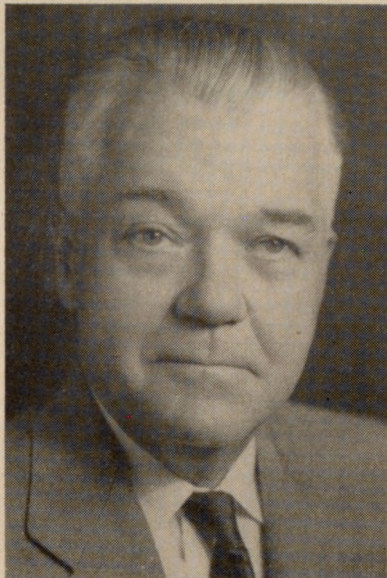
About ten years ago the sight of my eyes faded away. The Lord, recognizing my difficulty, immediately proceeded to do something about it.
