The Pauline Revelation

The struggle for faith ends when we turn to the Pauline Revelation for it alone holds the answer to the constant cry, "If I only had more faith!"

It is not more faith, in the ordinary sense of the word, that you need, but more knowledge and understanding of what you are in Christ, and this knowledge is found only in the Pauline Revelation.

What do we mean by the Pauline Revelation?

It is the Revelation that God, through the Spirit, gave to the Apostle Paul.

"For neither did I receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came to me through revelation of Jesus Christ." Gal. 1:12.

It is a Revelation of the mystery that had been kept hidden in the mind of the Father and now made known to the Apostle Paul to give to the Church "to bring about obedience to the faith."

"Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery which was kept secret for long ages but is now disclosed and through the prophetic writings is made known to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about obedience to the faith." Rom. 16:25, 26.

Paul called it "my gospel" to distinguish it from the Gospel preached by Christ and by John the Baptist.

The Gospel preached by Jesus and John the Baptist was a Gospel of works. It was a Gospel of the Kingdom for those under the Old Covenant.

"And Jesus went about all the cities and the villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom." Math. 9:35.

The Gospel that Paul preached was a Gospel of Grace for those under the New Covenant. "If so be that ye have heard of the dispensation of that grace of God which was given me to you-ward. . . ." Eph. 3:2.

The Father had chosen Paul and separated him and given to him the revelation of His Grace that was to govern the Church, and so we must go beyond the Gospels in our search for the message for today.

The faith of the Disciples was faith in Christ as the Son of God.

Martha didn't understand Christ when He told her that He was the resurrection and the life. She said, "Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, he who is coming into the world."

She had no conception of Redemptive truth.

Her faith was in the miracle working power of Christ and in His ability as the Son of God. It was in what He could do for them, and not in what He had already

accomplished through His Substitutionary Sacrifice.

Our faith today is not in what Christ is able to do because He is the Son of God, but in what He has already done for us in Redemption.

The Pauline Revelation is a revelation of what happened from the time that sin was laid upon Christ upon the Cross until He sat down at the Father's Right Hand.

It is an unveiling of what took place in the three days and nights before He arose from the dead.

This mystery was given to Paul and he makes it known to us in his Epistles.

The Epistles are a revelation of the place and position of the Church and we must look to their truths if we are to enter into and enjoy the blessings that are ours as New Creations.

Many do not experience New Covenant blessing because they unconsciously turn back to Old Covenant teaching.

The New Covenant is a Covenant of Grace and its teachings were given to the Apostle Paul, and so we must know his message if we are to grow in Grace and live under the blessings of the New Covenant.

THE HEAVEN HOPE

A mother said, "I did not think much about Heaven until baby left us. Then my heart cried for my baby, and I began to think of Heaven for the first time. Baby was waiting for me. My child that was a very part of myself, is waiting for me."

Jesus gave us the first conception of Heaven, of a life beyond the grave.

The reason why Heaven is imperative is that man is an eternal being. He is in God's class, and because He is an eternal being, there must be a home.

In the beginning God planned that man would live eternally in his body. But when sin came, the body became mortal, which means subject to death. Then He had to make other plans.

Jesus came and paid the penalty of man's transgression. And Jesus taught about His Father and about the Father's home. In almost every message that He gave, He inferred that He came out from the Father, that He had come into the world, and after a bit He was going to leave the world and go back to His Father.

But perhaps the most marvelous thing He ever said was, in John 14, "In My Father's house are many dwelling places. I go and prepare a place for you, and if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again to receive you unto myself that where I am, ye may be also."

Jesus remembered His home, for in His great high-priestly prayer in John 17, He said, "Father, give me the glory I had with thee before the world was." He reveals His preexistence, and now He has made provision for us to join Him in the Heavenly home.

No other religion has a Heavenly home. None of the philosophical religions have an intelligent conception of life beyond the grave.

The very suggestion of a Father and a family means a home, it means love, it means fellowship.

If I were an agnostic, I would want to believe in Heaven. I would want to believe in a home where love reigned, where hate and bitterness and jealousy could not have entrance.

I want to believe in Heaven. I know that I am an eternal being. I want to know that I have a legal right to go there when I die.

Jesus has assured us beyond any shadow of a doubt that there was a Heaven. And the Pauline epistles plainly tell us how to prepare for it.

The Heaven hope is universal. Man is eternity conscious.

A little child will ask its parent, "Mama, will I meet you and papa there? Will you hurry up and come?"

The mother, her eyes blinded with tears, holds her dying babe to her breast and whispers, "We will meet you there."

"Fear not, for I have redeemed thee; I have called thee by thy name, thou art mine." Is. 43:1.

There is a scripture in the book of Judges, the sixth chapter, that intrigues the heart of the New Creation.

Israel had gone wrong again and the Midianites prevailed against them.

They had destroyed their crops, they had stolen their cattle, and their herds and flocks came into the Holy Land and ate up the choicest of everything.

The Midianites had taken all they had.

They were forced to the caves to thrash their grain.

They had reached the lowest point of extremity, then they cried unto the Lord to send an angel.

The Angel came and sat under an oak tree which was in Ophrah. Gideon was threshing wheat in the wine press.

It is hard to believe that a Blood Covenant man was reduced to such a state.

The promise of Jehovah, "And one shall chase a thousand and two shall put 10,000 to flight," meant nothing to them.

Then the Angel appeared unto him and said, "Behold, Jehovah is with thee."

Gideon said, "Oh, my Lord, if Jehovah is with us, why then has all this befallen us?"

Gideon did not believe that he was a mighty man of valor.

He thought he was a poor weak worm of the dust; the rag end of a failure.

He thought like many of our Christians today.

You say to them, did you know that "greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world."

They reply, "Oh yes, I remember I read that."

I say to them again, did not Jesus say, "Whatsoever you ask of the Father in my name he will give it you."

They say, "Yes, the scripture says that."

It means no more to them than the angel's words did to Gideon.

Gideon said, "Did not Jehovah bring us up from Egypt? But now Jehovah hath cast us off, and delivered us into the hand of Midian."

You hear people say today, "If I just had faith, if I could only find someone to pray the prayer of faith for me, I would get my deliverance."

In the mind of the Father they are free.

They do not grasp the fact, "In whom we have our Redemption, through his blood, the remission of our sins."

They do not realize that "Nay in all these things we are more than conquerors."

They have listened to the voice of failure until there is no heart left in them.

The modern Church has developed a failure-consciousness.

They are weakness and failure minded.

Hear the last of this scripture, "Jehovah looked upon him and said, Go in this thy might and save Israel from the hand of Midian; have not I sent thee?"

The man with the inferiority complex said, "Oh, Lord, where-with shall I save Israel? behold my family is the poorest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house."

Here is inferiority highly developed.

The Angel was gentle, and said, "Surely I will be with thee, and thou shalt smite the Midianites as one man."

Then Gideon said, "Show me a sign" (so that I shall know beyond a shadow of a doubt that you will be with me.)

This is Sense Knowledge talking.

I can hear Gideon say, "I will tell you what I will do, I have a sheep skin here and I will put it out tonight. If the dew falls all around it and the sheep skin is left dry, then I will know of assurance that you called me."

The Angel said, Amen.

The sheep skin was put out and the next morning the ground was wet but the skin was dry.

Our hero looked at the dry sheep skin and the wet ground and he said, "Jehovah, let me try it once more. Do not be offended with me. If in the morning the sheep skin is wet and the ground is dry then I will know for sure that you have called me."

The next morning the sheep skin was wringing wet and I believe he must have wrung out quarts of water.

Now reader, here is a perfect example of a Sense Knowledge Christian.

He is forever asking for a sign. He wants some proof that God is with him.

He does not know that it is God who is at work within him.

He does not know the Word. He does not appreciate the integrity of the Word.

He lives in the realm of the senses.

The Word means almost nothing to him.

He may have had many great experiences, but he is always waiting for a new experience.

This is because he does not really believe the Word.

If he believed the Word he would not need an experience.

We do not need a sign, we have His Word.

We know that the Spirit created the physical body, and the Spirit is in us.

We know the power and authority of the Name.

We know we have a legal right to the use of it.

We know that the Name on our lips conquers the forces of darkness.

We know that the Holy Spirit is in us.

We know we have grace and ability to meet every emergency.

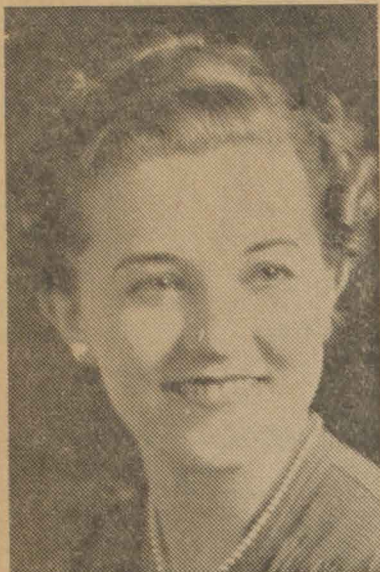

No Test — No Testimony

There comes a time in the trial of faith when we can have only the Word of God to stand upon. Every person, all circumstances, all Sense Knowledge evidence, reason and all other kinds of evidence usually thought to be authentic and dependable, will be in direct contradiction to the Word of God.

There is a blessedness in having only the Word of God to stand upon, for when we are shut up to God only for deliverance and so, have to look up, then we will look to the only source of supernatural deliverance. It was so with the Israelites throughout their history. It was so with the New Testament characters, and it is just the same today. Man's extremity is and always has been God's opportunity. We are best off when we have to trust God!

After we have stood resolutely and immovably upon the statements of God's Word, and have held fast to our confession of it in the face of well-meaning but un instructed friends, the facts of sense evidence and contrary circumstances, then God intervenes and teaches us a lesson He could have taught us in no other way.

Thus we learn by experience that God's Word is utterly reliable no matter how much reason or Sense Knowledge insist to the contrary. The only way we can learn to really trust God is by actually trusting Him when in perfect darkness. This means darkness as far as light from any source other than the Word.

Testings of our faith in the integrity of the Word of God give us the good and great opportunity of proving that God is true, even though man is a liar. They give us the opportunity to become strong in faith. George Muller, that great demonstrator of God's faithfulness to His Word, once said, "The only way to learn strong faith is to endure great trials. I have learned my faith by standing firm amid severe testings." Dr. A. B. Simpson, commenting upon Mr. Muller's statement, said, "He can teach you in these hours the mightiest trust in His Word which you can ever know." Smith Wigglesworth, that modern apostle of Faith, whose faith produced such a continuous stream of amazing miracles of healing, said, "Great faith is the product of great fights. Great testimonies are the outcome of great tests. Great triumphs can only come out of great trials."

There is just no other way to prove to ourselves that God's Word is always utterly reliable. We learn all of our best lessons from "the hard knocks of experience."

Through our actual experience of standing the trial, we come to believe in the Word of God with a more firm and steadfast faith than we would if a hundred witnesses would stand up and tell us they had proved the complete reliability of the Word. Herein lies the reason for our faith having to be tried. It gives us personal faith in the Word of God as being the present, living voice of God.

We never could obtain such a faith if we listened to the testimonies of multitudes of other people and read every book ever written for the purpose of creating and fortifying faith. The testimonies and inspiring words of others who have learned by experience have their place. They do encourage us and keep us in the fight of faith, but they cannot give us faith. This comes only from the Word of God and our standing true to it when all else contradicts it.

There are some lessons we can learn only through our own personal experience, and the most precious of these lessons is the lesson of faith.

After we have stood the supreme trial of faith we are able to establish our brethren. As Jesus said to Peter, "When thou hast turned again, establish thy brethren." As we give of our spiritual strength to

strengthen their faith, we are made stronger ourselves in faith. It is the old principle of getting by giving. But before we are able to give, we must get, and the only way to get strong faith in God is to endure and survive great tests of faith in Him.

In the midst of trial, sometimes we are inclined to think that it is an effort of the evil one to take away whatever faith we have. It can have that result, but it need not have, and it will not if we only keep on believing and declare with job, "Though he slay me, yet will I trust Him!"

Every trial of faith is a glorious opportunity. It is an opportunity to have our faith established stronger than before. Then and not until then can our voice have that ring of sincerity and experience, so encouraging to other saints, as we exclaim, "I know that God's Word is true!" The proving of our faith has made us "perfect and entire, lacking in nothing." (James 1:2-4.)

The very fulness of God unveiled in Christ is now ours.

Col. 2:9 "For in Him dwelleth all the fulness of the God head bodily, and in Him ye are made full" or made complete "who is the head of all principality and power."

In Him you are made complete, made full with His fulness. You can understand why the Spirit said through Paul "I can do all things in Him who enables me."

You are passing out of the realm of Sense Knowledge into the realm of God's ability where God's strength is your strength, where God's fulness is your fulness.

"God is faithful, through whom ye were called into the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord." 1 Cor. 1:9.

APPEAL FROM CHINA

Thank you very much for your good letter of June 1st. We certainly need your prayers these days, as we are living in not only difficult but dangerous days. Yet the opportunities are wonderful. God is still on the throne and He does not make mistakes. We can rejoice in His goodness.

Since my arrival in Hongkong, I have been getting in touch with our people in Shanghai by cable. It is an expensive way of correspondence, but this is the only way just now. The Nationalists' blockade is effective and no letters are getting through. We are very happy to know that all children and workers are safe.

Remittances are still getting through, but prices are terrible. Rice has been sold at thirty cents, American money, for one pound.

Our Bible College quietly carried on even after the Communists came to take over our city. Five fine young people graduated this summer. Our missionaries in Kiangsi had to flee from the Communists fighting their way toward our field. Now the two ladies are in West China finding new fields of service, and one family has gone to Formosa to work. He must give out the Living Word even if he has to flee from one city to another.

Our work in Formosa is wonderfully blessed by God. We are still looking for a place for an orphanage here in Hongkong and also a school for the ministers' children.

Not far in the future we will begin our broadcast. May God use our voices to reach China's millions even though we cannot reach them in person. For this forward movement we need \$10,000 and are trusting the Lord to supply. Please pray for this.

Mrs. Gih has already come out of the hospital, but she will continue her treatment for six months before she will be able to shoulder her responsibilities. Please pray for her, too.

Since I came back about four weeks ago, I have had two successful campaigns already. The large churches were packed as people had to sit outside the church to listen. We had nearly 600 decisions for Christ.

The hearts are hungry. I preached in open air here and nearly 2000 stood in the streets and listened, some of them for nearly two hours. About 100 expressed their wishes to become Christians. Praise the Lord for the Gospel is still the power of God.

**Why Paul Did Not
Urge Believers to Believe**

In the greater percentage of Orthodox sermons on spiritual things, you will hear the speaker urging the people to believe.

Telling them what could be done if they really had faith.

These preachers have followed Jesus' teachings to the Jews rather than Paul's unveiling of the New Creation in Christ.

Jesus was talking to an apostate people.

They were Covenant people, but they had fallen away from the Covenant light and Jesus was urging them to believe in God.

Paul is writing to believers telling them that the children are possessors.

Jesus said, "He that believeth hath."

In other words, you can not be a believer without being a partaker.

You may be a "Mental Assenter" and say, "Yes, the Bible is true," but you do not enjoy it.

You may be a "Hoper" and look on the Bible with a great deal of pleasure. You may say, "It's a wonderful book."

"Hopers" have never partaken of the Divine Life.

Some day they may receive Eternal Life.

Hope is always future.

"Mental Assent" is looking at the thing, admiring it, but never enjoying it.

A Believer enjoys the things that the Word has promised.

He is a partaker of the Divine Nature.

He is in the Family of God.

All that Christ did in His Redemptive Work belongs to him.

He believes that all that Christ is now belongs to him.

Just as your head belongs to your body, so the Head of the Church belongs to the Body, the Church.

We are Redeemed the moment we take Christ as Saviour.

Redemption becomes a fact the moment that we receive Eternal Life.

We become New Creations, we are the sons and daughters of God. All of our sins have been remitted, wiped out as though they had never been.

There is no "sin hangover."

Our sin nature was put away and a new nature was given to us.

Our old self was nailed to the cross with Christ, and a new self was Resurrected with Him.

When we accept Christ, that New Self becomes a reality.

The Holy Spirit belongs to us.

We do not have to pray, fast, or tarry for Him. He is ours.

"How much more will your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him."

Then you take your place, and enjoy your rights and privileges in Christ.

The Name of Jesus belongs to us.

All authority is wrapped up in that Name.

It is our personal property, that is, it is the property of every Believer.

God is the Father of every New Creation.

He is no longer God, He is my Father, your Father.

He is a Lover.

He loved me, and gave His son to die for me.

Jesus is our Lord.

When you realize that Jesus is your Bread Provider, your Protector and Shield, the One who loved you enough to die for you, and ever lives to make Intercession for you, if you do wrong He is your Advocate before the Father, then faith becomes an unconscious asset.

You have the Holy Spirit as a Teacher, Guide and Comforter.

The Word is God's living message in the present tense for you now.

What it did on the lips of Jesus, it will do on your lips.

What it did on the lips of the Apostles, as recorded in Acts and

the Epistles, it will do on your lips today.

Healing is ours.

I wish I could make it so simple that every one who reads this, will grasp this fact.

"Surely he has borne our sickness and carried our pains, and we have come to esteem him as the one who was stricken, smitten of God and afflicted. He was wounded for our transgression, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His stripes we are healed." (Lit.)

You see, you need no special faith for your healing, because you are already healed.

The moment that you accept Jesus, in the mind of the Father and Christ, you are perfectly healed.

It requires no faith on your part to take what belongs to you.

He says, "I write unto you little children that you sin not, and if you do sin you have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous one."

It does not require any faith to look up and say, "Father, I am sorry that I did that."

Jesus then becomes your personal Attorney to look after your case and restore your broken fellowship.

He is yours, you are His.

You see, Jesus is made unto you wisdom.

It belongs to you, it is yours to use every day.

It makes no difference what your needs are along this line, they have all been met in Christ.

All you do is enjoy them.

John 8:12 "I am the light of the world, he that followeth me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."

Now notice this, light means wisdom and ability.
