JEWS MAY FORM ENTIRE NEW NATION

TURN THEIR EYES TO ABANDONED PALESTINE.

Objects Are to Establish Colonies, Banks, Schools, and Other Institutions and to Develop a Material Spirit.

New York, Nov. 18--Ten years ago the word "Zionist" was coined to denote those Jews who were actively working to restore their race to the Holy Land. It is a new word for a very old movement.

Today Zionism is a powerful movement. It is world wide. It has more than 2,000 socieites and 400,000 members. It supports fifty publications of its own. And out of the 12,000,000 Jews in all parts of the world, there are fully 10,000,000 worse feelings and good wishes are on the side of the Zionist.

In the United States, where there are 2,000,000 Jews, probably 10 per cent of these are in active sympathy with the Zionists, and even those who do not help it regard it as a pleasant dream. Among the young Jews especially Zionism is growing like a new religion.
