Our Faith must include corresponding action. If it does not, it is only Mental Assent, and is a dead Faith.

In I Thess. 2:13, Paul declares that the Word works for those who believe it. ". . . ye accepted it not as the word of men, but, as it is in truth, the Word of God, which also worketh in you that believe."

It it as some misunderstand it now. is present tense. The Authorized Version reads, "And ye are com-plete in Him." Smith and Goodspeed's translation of this passage helps to throw light upon it. It reads, "For it is in Him that all the fulness of God's nature lives embodied, and in union with Him you too are filled with it." Notice again the present tense and that it is a statement of fact, not of fancy or of hope. It is just a plain, simple fact that we, as born again children of God, are now made full or complete.

The Twentieth Century New Testament makes this passage read this way, "For in Christ the Godhead in all its fulness dwells incarnate; and by your union with Him, you also are filled with it." Note the present tense, "are filled in the original plan. They are an
