The third annual Easter meeting commemorating the planting of the Apostolic Faith movement in the state of Texas was held at Orchard, beginning April 19. At the expiration of ten days (the time the meeting was advertised to continue) it was found impossible to close it, and it was continued over another week, closing May 3d. The power and influence of the meeting was felt not only in the immediate vicinity of Orchard but all over the state of Texas. Nor was that the limit, for there were delegates there from many states, from all of the missions in the southland, and the influences that have gone out from that meeting will be felt in the earth when Jesus comes.

It is impossible to give a graphic description of the work done, or the power of the meeting in a limited degree, for there was such a wonderful outpouring of the Holy Spirit that the finite mind of man cannot do justice in explanations,

or picturing it. To say that God is alive, and his power manifest in this day and age of the world, and to say that He in a marvelous manner was present to bestow all of the power, the gifts and graces of the REAL Apostolic church, and that these were given in that meeting in a way and manner never before known is not overdrawing the picture.

Every one of the nine gifts were manifested in one day, and so wondrous was the presence of the Holy Spirit that men and women stood in awe at his workings. God gave a discernment to his children that enabled them to read the lives of others, and to such a marked degree that they fell prostrate at the altar begging for mercy, acknowledging that these things were true. Lives were made as an open book, confessions were made, differences were righted, hidden secrets were made known, and before God and man restitutions were made.

There were marvelous healings; wonderful deliverances from demonical spirits and control. God's wondrous power to free from habits and passion, saving, sanctifying, healing and pentecostal power was made manifest in a marvelous manner. From the very beginning of the meeting, and from day to day, the tide of power rose higher and higher.

It was a wonderful meeting; I doubt if it has ever had an equal in modern times. Since the days when John the Baptist's voice rang out in the wilderness, I do not believe there has been a meeting that so captured the real attention of people as did this--as in Apostolic days when the voice of that noted preacher, Peter, spoke on the day of Pentecost and the great power of God was so wonderfully manifested. I doubt if since those

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days there has ever been a coming together of the saints of God attended with more power than in that seventeen days at Orchard.

With all of these outpourings, infillings, blessings, in various ways, in the spiritual, there were likewise such blessings in a temporal way that we can scarcely account for it otherwise than to say that it was miraculous. The way in which every provision in the way of the material was made and met was nothing short of a miracle.

As we look back and see the multitudes that God provided for, as we see the hungry that were fed on the temporal bread, we say, "God reigns and rules." As we remember the many that were fed upon the bread of life, the real truths of God, the real manna from heaven, we again exclaim, "Bless the Lord, O my soul."

After the meeting closed at Orchard, we came to Houston and again opened services in the Old Shearn M.E. church, and God has been with us in great power, and men and women are getting saved, healed and blessed. The power of Pentecost has fallen here again and we are going on to a glorious victory Hallelujah!
