We cannot believe beyond actual knowledge, and if God Almighty has demanded that I believe that Jesus of Nazareth is the incarnate God, that He died for my sins and arose from the dead that I might be set right with Him, I demand that He give me evidence upon which I can base such a faith. If He asks me to have faith when it is impossible, then I have a right to challenge His justice, but if He places in my hands the means whereby that faith can be produced, then the responsibility rests with me.


