He was the accepted Mediator between God and man, the Man Christ Jesus.

He was not only that, but He was the accepted Intercessor for the people for whom He had died.

Those who accept Him as Saviour and confess Him as Lord have Him as their Intercessor, for He ever lives to make Intercession for them.

Not only is He the great Intercessor but He is the Advocate.

Whenever a man of the Body of Christ is tripped up, He is there to take the case before the Supreme Court of the Universe.

Now understand me, He is the One who loved you and gave Himself up for you. Now, He is defending you. Not only that, and that is enough to thrill any heart, but He is your Lord, your bread provider, your caretaker.

You can say now, "the Lord is my Shepherd, my Sup... He meets my every need, He is my Caretaker."

You see how safely one could go into the foreign field, like Africa, India or China with a consciousness that I am a master.

They may be as frail as Paul was in his latter years after being locked in the Roman dungeon where he wrote Ephesians, Philippians, and Colossians, and Hebrews besides the personal Epistles.

Those Epistles have a message that is going to sweep the universe with grace in these last days.

You are limitless, you have the life of God on your lips.

I wonder if you realize what that means. You have the same Word that God used when He created the universe. All He had to do was to say "let there be" and at once one part of creation after another leaped into being.

Jesus used the Father's Words and healed the sick and raised the dead. He simply said, "Lazarus, come forth."

That living force is a Divine force in the lips of faith.

You are God's Righteous one who lives by faith.

You walk by faith and not the senses.

You are walking in the Word. You are walking in the light of God's life.

You remember what Jesus said, "He that followeth me shall not walk in the darkness but shall have the light of life."

You have the light of life. There is the light of God in that light. It is the ability of God the Father and it is yours.

You are a Master of Satan.

How it thrilled me when I first realized this truth.

Jesus did not arise from the dead until He had conquered Satan.

Our Redemption is an Eternal Redemption.

"He put off from himself the principalities and the powers and made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it." Col. 2:15.

You see He conquered the hosts

of darkness that had held Him in bondage. He did this before He arose from the dead.

He stripped them of their authority, left them defeated behind Him.

His victory was your victory. He did not do it for Himself. He did not live to.

He was your Substitute. What He did to the Devil He did for you.

He conquered him for you.

Had He not conquered him, Peter could not have healed the man at the beautiful gate with the Name of Jesus, nor could Paul have cast out the demons with that Name.

You see they are defeated, conquered forces, and any child of God can dominate them through the Name.

Never let the Adversary fill you with fear. You are an absolute master.

Peter and Paul had nothing you do not have.

If they healed the sick and raised the dead in that Name, you too can do it.

It is not you, it is the Name of Jesus.

It is your confidence in the Name that makes you a master of circumstances.

Let this truth become a part of your being.

You have been Redeemed from the hand of the enemy.

"In whom we have our redemption through his blood, the remission of our trespasses."

You see it is God's own Redemption.

Hear this, "Who delivered us out of the authority of darkness and translated us into the kingdom of the Son of his love." Col. 1:13

You see you are a master, you are a conqueror.

You are taking Jesus' place and acting with the authority of the Father.

Demons fear you when they know that you know who you are and what you are in Christ.

I wonder if you have ever realized what the Word means in I Cor. 1:9 "God is faithful, through whom ye were called into the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord."

Notice it carefully. "Called into the fellowship." Fellowship means sharing, bearing the burdens together.

You have been called into fellowship with Jesus Christ. That means you have become a sharer with the Master in the salvation of the universal race.

He has drafted your ability. That ability may be to make money. He owns that ability. It may be that you can write or teach or sing. Whatever it may be, you are sharing it with the Master and you are sharing His personal responsibility for this lost world.

You see when the Father gave Jesus as a Substitute for you, Jesus assumed the responsibility of seeing you stand perfect before the Father.

Now you and I are sharing that responsibility. We are to lead men to Christ and see that they are instructed in the Word.

It is as though He stood at your side and said, "I have called you to help me reach that man and woman, or that community or that nation."

Just as He called Paul to go to Ephesus He is calling you to go to that person who has been a burden on your heart.

You are to say from now, "I am going to give You my ability, I

want to share Your love nature that we might be one in this new wonderful life."

Some Facts about Paul

Did Paul enjoy the realities of all that he wrote?

Did the reality of Redemption become a part of his own life?

No, he often wrote beyond his own experiences.

He had to do that because the Revelation had to be made known to him before he could experience it.

We have had the Revelation, understood it sometimes for months before we could enter into it and have it become a part of us.

No one knew anything about what happened to Jesus on the cross until it was revealed to the apostle Paul.

No one knew what happened to Him during the three days and three nights. They did not even know where He was.

None of those nearest to Him really knew who He was.

They knew He was a prophet. They called Him the Son of God, but they did not understand the importance of such a statement.

He was an enigma, a mystery.

No one knew what took place in His great Substitutionary Sacrifice until it was unveiled to Paul.

When one realizes that there are perhaps more than one hundred utterly new things given to Paul that no other religious teacher or philosopher had ever known of or written about, then we can understand how difficult it would be for a man without any Christian experiences back of him, save his old Covenant truths.

Paul had been a religious man but he did not have Eternal Life. When he received Eternal Life he had no pattern to follow other than Jesus Christ.

We are not expecting him to be free of all prejudices of the Jews, or his reverence of the offerings and sacrifices. They have been a part of his life from childhood.

It is no wonder, when he went up to Jerusalem the last time that the brethren prevailed upon him to make a sacrifice. They knew that if he did, it would stop persecution. But it meant the end of Paul's public ministry in Judea.

He had written to Galatia about the law and about the sacrifices, they were not his opinions, they were Revelation truths.

He had never dreamed of them before.

They were not something that he had worked out by laborious reasoning.

They came like a picture on the screen.

To adjust his life to this new life was just as difficult for him as it is for us.

Now we can understand, in a measure at least, that wonderful statement in II Cor. 12:7-10 "And by reason of the exceeding greatness of the revelations, that I should not be exalted overmuch, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, that I should not be exalted overmuch. Concerning this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. And he hath said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my power is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

This "thorn in the flesh" was a person, not a disease nor infirmity.

It was a being. He called it a messenger from Satan, that would slap him across the mouth to make him stutter, and halt his speech.

Concerning this thing he besought the Lord thrice that it might depart from him.

It was a demon.

It is not strange that a demon should afflict Paul, and that the Father would not give him immediate deliverance.

What man could receive such a startling Revelation without becoming exalted?

God did not send the demon, but in His great ability and wisdom He used the demon that came to hurt Paul and injure his ministry.

If the Father had wanted someone to afflict Paul, He would have sent an angel of His own choosing, but this was an angel of Satan.

If Paul were sick it would be the most normal thing in the world, because he had no Christian background or examples.

He was a pioneer in Eternal Life.

Eternal Life was only twenty-three or four years old in the world.

No one could tell him their experiences.

He could not send to a tract society for the experiences of George Muller, D. Simpson or John G. Paton.

Paul had no one to fall back upon but the Lord.

If he left one of his helpers sick behind him, it was not to be wondered at.

After nineteen hundred years of Christian experiences we know very few men who live above those attacks of the enemy.

If we knew the inner life of every one of our great spiritual leaders, we would find that Satan had afflicted them in some way.

I remember that Ivan Panin once said to me, "the Christian graces are usually of very slow growth."

One may know much about the Hebrew and Greek. He may know all about what we call the great doctrines. He may be honored above all his fellow men, and yet he may not be able to take advantage of the grace and ability that belongs to him in Christ.

He may not know some of the key facts of Redemption that would have set him free.

We have not grown up to them yet.

Let us be slow to judge and quick to love.

Let us do away with criticism and give ourselves over to love.

Here are some facts that we might think about.

Paul did not write from experiences, but from God.

He wrote what gives experiences.

Our experiences are largely the products of the senses.

Acting on the Word and walking in love are vitally more important.

Most of us write our experiences.

Paul wrote a Revelation from God.

A Revelation does not need experiences to verify it, it is God speaking.
