Introduction

The year 2018 marked the centennial anniversary of Oral Roberts' birth. In celebration of that anniversary, *Spiritus: ORU Journal of Theology* published a special issue commemorating Oral Roberts.¹ The issue included a bibliography of Roberts' 150 published works, thirteen biographies, and fifteen academic studies, theses, and dissertations. The bibliography aimed to provide resources to contribute to the study of Oral Roberts' life and ministry and inspire new research into this significant figure. This current list serves as a supplement to the first bibliography. It adds numerous academic studies about Oral Roberts since 2018, many of which were published in *Spiritus*. This supplemental bibliography now includes studies on Oral Roberts University (ORU).

The publication of the new bibliography is fitting, considering ORU recently announced the creation of a new Center for Spirit–Empowered Research (C4SER). This center aims to enhance Spirit–empowered scholarship within and beyond the ORU community to serve global Spirit-empowered Christianity and the global church. Under the auspices of the C4SER, the Holy Spirit Resource Center (HSRC) houses one of the world's most comprehensive Pentecostal-Charismatic and Holy Spirit collections. With its vast resources on the Holy Spirit and related topics, the C4SER welcomes and wishes to help facilitate global, regional, and local scholarship into the Spirit-empowered Movement, not least studies about Oral Roberts and Oral Roberts University.

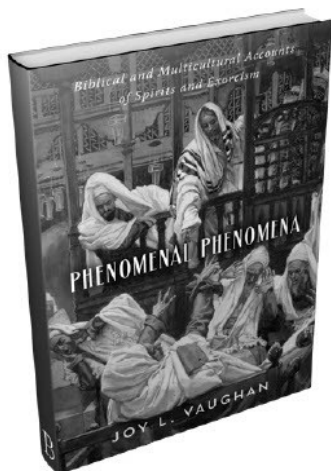
Conclusion

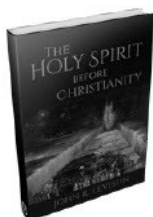

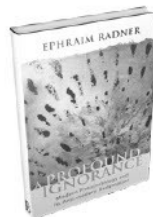
